

Industry Breakdown for Output-Based GDP

In the presentation of output-based GDP, industries are classified according to the Singapore Standard Industrial Classification (SSIC) 2005, which provides the basic framework for the classification of economic activities.

The format by which output-based GDP is presented, and the corresponding sections in the SSIC 2005 are shown below:
