SINGAPORE STANDARD EDUCATIONAL CLASSIFICATION 2010

The Singapore Department of Statistics is pleased to announce the release of the publication, Singapore Standard Educational Classification (SSEC) 2010.

The SSEC provides a common framework for classifying educational programmes and qualifications. The SSEC 2010 consists of three components – level of education attending, level of educational qualification attained and field of study. It is reviewed and updated from the first version to reflect new developments and changes in the education system in Singapore as well as to align with the international standard.

This publication supersedes the previous edition and describes the principles, scope and structure of the classification. Comparison tables of SSEC 2000 and SSEC 2010 for the three components are also included to facilitate better understanding of the changes.
