



## Personal Disposable Income and Saving

## Third Quarter 2022

In nominal terms, personal disposable income grew by 9.8 per cent on a year-on-year basis in the third quarter 2022, following the 7.2 per cent increase in the previous quarter. Growth during the quarter was largely supported by growth in compensation of employees and higher GSTV – Cash payout<sup>1</sup>.

Personal saving declined 3.3 per cent on a year-on-year basis in the third quarter 2022, improving from the 13 per cent contraction in the second quarter. The decline in personal saving could be attributed to a strong growth in private consumption expenditure. The personal saving rate, which is defined as the share of personal saving out of personal disposable income, increased from 28.7 per cent in the second quarter to 31.4 per cent in the third quarter.

<sup>1</sup> A GSTV – Cash Special Payment was announced by Deputy Prime Minister Mr Lawrence Wong on 21 June 2022 as part of a \$1.5 billion package to help Singaporeans cope with higher inflation. The regular GSTV – Cash payment has also been enhanced, as announced in Budget 2022. Compared to last year, the regular GSTV – Cash payout is \$100 higher.
