



In 2021, Singapore's Services Sector¹ generated \$4,441 billion in operating revenue, representing an increase of 33.4 per cent over 2020.

Most industries within Singapore's Services Sector recorded higher operating revenue in 2021 compared to the previous year as the economy recovers from the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. In particular, the Transportation & Storage industry registered the highest increase in operating revenue of 59.3 per cent, followed by the Wholesale Trade and Information & Communications industries with 33.7 per cent and 29.1 per cent respectively. In contrast, the Accommodation & Food Services industry recorded lower operating revenue in 2021 as global travel restrictions continued to weigh down demand for accommodation services.
