

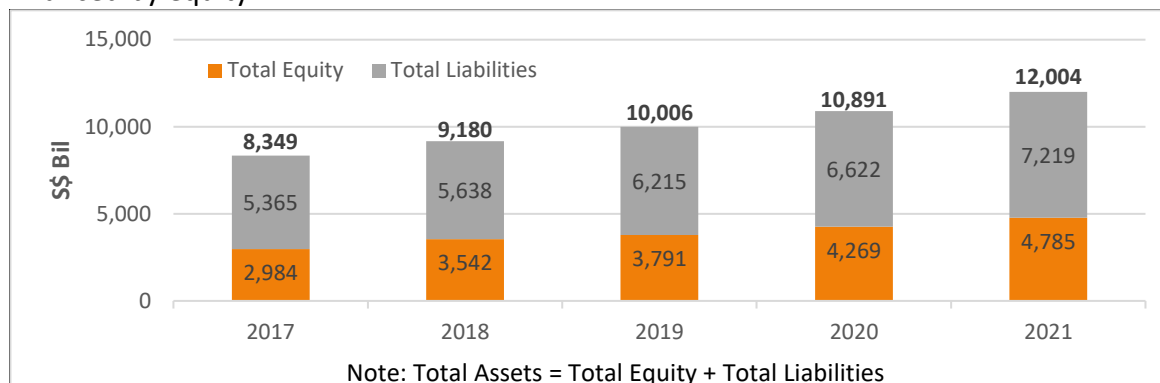


Financial Structure of Singapore's Corporate Sector

2021

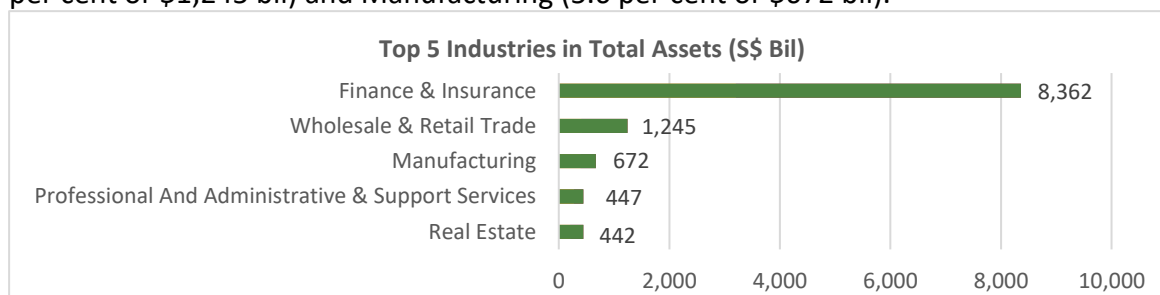
BALANCE SHEET COMPOSITION

Total assets of the corporate sector increased 10.2 per cent from \$10,891 bil as at end 2020 to \$12,004 bil as at end 2021. 39.9 per cent or \$4,785 bil of the total assets were financed by equity.



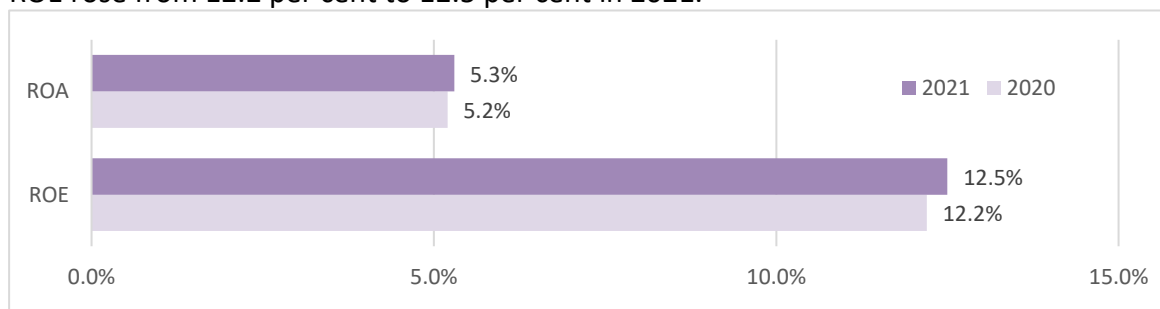
TOTAL ASSETS BY INDUSTRY

The Finance & Insurance industry accounted for 69.7 per cent (or \$8,362 bil) of the total assets in the corporate sector as at end 2021, followed by Wholesale & Retail Trade (10.4 per cent or \$1,245 bil) and Manufacturing (5.6 per cent or \$672 bil).



PROFITABILITY RATIOS

The corporate sector reported higher Return on Assets (ROA) and Return on Equity (ROE) in 2021 compared to 2020. ROA increased by 0.1 percentage point to 5.3 per cent while ROE rose from 12.2 per cent to 12.5 per cent in 2021.
