# **April 2018**

# **Import Price Index**

#### Change over previous month

The Import Price Index rose 1.4 per cent in April 2018, in contrast to the 0.6 per cent decrease in March 2018. The Oil index climbed 5.8 per cent, following the 0.1 per cent increase in the previous month, due mainly to higher prices of crude petroleum and diesel fuel & fuel oils. The Non-oil index fell 0.1 per cent in April 2018, after the 0.8 per cent decline in March.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, decreases led by the Beverages & Tobacco (-0.6 per cent) and Machinery & Transport Equipment (-0.2 per cent) indices were partially moderated by increases in the Chemicals & Chemical Products (0.7 per cent) and Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (0.2 per cent) indices.

## Change over same period of previous year

The Import Price Index rose 2.0 per cent in April 2018 from a year ago, following the 1.5 per cent increase in March 2018. The Oil index rose 17.3 per cent, while the Non-oil index decreased 2.4 per cent.

For the Non-oil sub-indices, lower prices of Animal & Vegetable Oils (-8.6 per cent), Machinery & Transport Equipment (-3.7 per cent), Food & Live Animals (-2.8 per cent), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-2.7 per cent), Beverages & Tobacco (-1.7 per cent) and Crude Materials (-1.2 per cent) were partially offset by higher prices of Manufactured Goods (2.7 per cent) and Chemicals & Chemical Products (1.9 per cent).

# **Export Price Index**

#### Change over previous month

The Export Price Index increased 1.2 per cent in April 2018, against the 0.3 per cent decline in March 2018. The Oil index rose 6.1 per cent, in contrast to the 0.4 per cent decrease in the previous month, due to higher prices of bunker fuel and high speed diesel fuel. The Non-oil index was unchanged, after the 0.3 per cent decline in March.


For the Non-oil sub-indices, increases led by the Manufactured Goods (0.9 per cent) and Chemicals & Chemical Products (0.2 per cent) indices were offset by declines led by the Beverages & Tobacco (-1.3 per cent) and Food & Live Animals (-0.9 per cent) indices.


#### Change over same period of previous year

The Export Price Index rose 0.7 per cent in April 2018 over the previous year, in contrast to the 0.7 per cent decline in March 2018. The Oil index rose 18.2 per cent while the Non-oil index fell 2.9 per cent.


Among the Non-oil sub-indices, declines in the Animal & Vegetable Oils (-7.0 per cent), Beverages & Tobacco (-4.2 per cent), Machinery & Transport Equipment (-4.0 per cent), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-3.5 per cent), Food & Live Animals (-3.3 per cent) and Crude Materials (-2.5 per cent) indices were partially moderated by increases in the Manufactured Goods (1.7 per cent) and Chemicals & Chemical Products (0.1 per cent) indices.

## TECHNICAL NOTE

The *Import Price Index (IPI)* is used primarily as an indicator to track the price trends of imported goods into Singapore. Prices of imports, valued at cif (cost, insurance and freight) are obtained monthly from major importers. The weighting pattern of the index is derived from import statistics for 2012.

The *Export Price Index (EPI)* measures changes in the price of all exports of merchandise from Singapore, including re-exports. In general, prices are obtained from major exporters of the selected commodities. Prices used in the index computation, are the prices of goods that physically leave Singapore's main ports of export; also termed as free on board prices. The weights of the index are derived from the distribution of export by commodity in 2012.

#### **Index Formula**

The 2012-based series is compiled using the Laspeyres formula where the price and weight reference periods are aligned to the year 2012. The geometric mean (GM) formula has been adopted in the computation of unweighted elementary aggregate price indices. The arithmetic mean (AM) formula is applied in compiling indices at higher levels of aggregation where weights of specific sub-indices are available

#### **Measurement of Changes in Price Indices**

**Change over previous month** compares the index of the month with that of the preceding month. Such comparisons measure the change in the price index between two consecutive months. They serve as useful short-term indicators of the price movements. As the price indices are found not to be seasonal, it is not necessary for seasonal adjustment to be carried out.

*Change over same period of previous year* measures change in the index over a twelve-month period. Such comparisons compare the movement in the price index between similar months in two consecutive years.
