






The Import Price Index fell 2.1% in December 2023, following the 2.4% decrease in November 2023. The Oil index dropped 5.7%, extending the 6.8% decrease in the previous month. The Non-oil index declined 0.6% in December 2023, after the 0.5% decrease in November 2023.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, the decreases were led by the Chemicals & Chemical Products (-0.9%), Manufactured Goods (-0.8%) and Machinery & Transport Equipment (-0.7%) indices.

Year-on-Year Change





The Import Price Index rose 0.7% in December 2023 from a year ago, in contrast to the 1.1% decrease in November 2023. The Oil index increased 2.8% while the Non-oil index fell 0.1%.


For the Non-oil sub-indices, lower prices of Animal & Vegetable Oils (-16.1%), Manufactured Goods (-3.6%), Food & Live Animals (-1.5%), Chemicals & Chemical Products (-0.9%) and Machinery & Transport Equipment (-0.2%) were partially offset by higher prices of Beverages & Tobacco (13.7%), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (3.0%) and Crude Materials (0.9%).

Annual Change

The Import Price Index fell 5.6% in 2023 over 2022, reversing the 14.4% increase in 2022. This was due to lower prices of Animal & Vegetable Oils (-20.9%), Oil (-16.3%), Manufactured Goods (-4.4%), Chemicals & Chemical Products (-3.0%) and Machinery & Transport Equipment (-0.1%).






The Export Price Index fell 2.4% in December 2023, following the 2.3% decrease in November 2023. The Oil index dropped 6.0%, extending the 7.1% decrease in the previous month. The Non-oil index declined 1.4% in December 2023, after the 0.7% decrease in November 2023.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, the decreases were led by the Machinery & Transport Equipment (-1.8%) and Chemicals & Chemical Products (-1.1%) indices, mainly due to lower prices of electrical machinery apparatus and organic chemicals respectively, and the Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-0.3%) index.

Year-on-Year Change





The Export Price Index fell 2.1% in December 2023 from a year ago, following the 3.7% decrease in November 2023. The Oil and Non-oil indices fell 3.8% and 1.6% respectively.

For the Non-oil sub-indices, lower prices of Animal & Vegetable Oils (-13.3%), Crude Materials (-7.7%), Chemicals & Chemical Products (-4.4%), Manufactured Goods (-3.1%), Food & Live Animals (-2.2%) and Machinery & Transport Equipment (-1.1%) were partially offset by higher prices of Beverages & Tobacco (8.2%) and Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (0.5%).

Annual Change

The Export Price Index dropped 7.6% in 2023 over 2022, reversing the 15.9% increase in 2022. This was due to lower prices of Oil (-16.2%), Animal & Vegetable Oils (-12.9%), Crude Materials (-12.0%), Chemicals & Chemical Products (-7.9%), Machinery & Transport Equipment (-4.2%), Manufactured Goods (-3.4%), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-3.4%) and Food & Live Animals (-2.8%).

Technical Note

The **Import Price Index (IPI)** is used primarily as an indicator to track the price trends of imported goods into Singapore. Prices of imports, valued at CIF terms (cost, insurance and freight) are obtained monthly from major importers. The weighting pattern of the index is derived from import statistics for 2018.

The **Export Price Index (EPI)** measures changes in the price of all exports of merchandise from Singapore, including re-exports. In general, prices are obtained from major exporters of the selected commodities. Prices used in the index computation, are the prices of goods that physically leave Singapore's main ports of export; also termed as Free on Board (FOB) prices. The weights of the index are derived from the distribution of export by commodity in 2018.

Index Formula

The 2018-based series is compiled using the Laspeyres formula where the price and weight reference periods are aligned to the year 2018. The geometric mean formula has been adopted in the computation of unweighted elementary aggregate price indices. The arithmetic mean formula is applied in compiling indices at higher levels of aggregation where weights of specific sub-indices are available.

Measurement of Changes in Price Indices

Change over previous month compares the index of the month with that of the preceding month. Such comparisons measure the change in the price index between two consecutive months. They serve as useful short-term indicators of the price movements.

Change over same period of previous year measures change in the index over a twelve-month period. Such comparisons compare the movement in the price index between similar months in two consecutive years.

Linking the Old 2012-Based Price Index Series to the New 2018-Based Price Index Series

The IPI and EPI have been rebased from base year 2012 to base year 2018. To facilitate comparison of the historical price indices across base years, the old 2012-based series are linked to the new 2018-based series by re-scaling them via a Linked Coefficient. The Linked Coefficient is the ratio of the annual 2018-based index in 2018 to the annual 2012-based index in 2018.

Example: Linking the old Iron & Steel Index series for IPI prior to 2018, to the 2018-based Iron & Steel Index (2018=100)

1) Calculate the linked coefficient

Linking Method for Maintaining the Old Index Reference Period

To continue the old 2012-based index series going forward in time, re-scale the new 2018-based index series to the old base year 2012 level, via a Linked Coefficient. The Linked Coefficient is the ratio of the annual 2012-based index in 2018 to the annual 2018-based index in 2018.

Example: Linking the new 2018-based Iron & Steel Index series for IPI to the 2012-based Iron & Steel Index (2012=100)

1) Calculate the linked coefficient


Import Price Index (2018 = 100) December 2023








Export Price Index (2018 = 100) December 2023






