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
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### Import Price Index (2018 = 100) February 2019

#### Month-on-Month Change







The Import Price Index rose 1.3% in February 2019, in contrast to the 1.4% decrease in January 2019. The Oil index increased 6.4%, against the 3.9% decline in the previous month. The Non-oil index fell 0.2% in February 2019, after decreasing 0.6% in January 2019.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, decreases led by the Machinery & Transport Equipment (-0.3%) and Chemicals & Chemical Products (-0.2%) indices were partially moderated by increases in the Crude Materials (0.4%) and Manufactured Goods (0.1%) indices.

#### Year-on-Year Change






The Import Price Index rose 4.3% in February 2019 from a year ago, following the 2.2% increase in January 2019. The Oil and Non-oil indices increased 8.5% and 3.0% respectively.

All Non-oil sub-indices increased with the exception of the Animal & Vegetable Oils (-15.2%) index. Higher prices were registered for Machinery & Transport Equipment (4.5%), Beverages & Tobacco (2.5%), Crude Materials (1.6%), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (1.4%), Food & Live Animals (0.6%), Manufactured Goods (0.5%) and Chemicals & Chemical Products (0.1%).

## Export Price Index (2018 = 100) February 2019


#### Month-on-Month Change



The Export Price Index rose 1.2% in February 2019, against the 0.4% decrease in January 2019. The Oil index increased 5.9%, in contrast to the 1.9% decrease in the previous month. The Non-oil index went up 0.2% in February 2019, after falling 0.1% in the previous month.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, increases led by the Manufactured Goods (1.0%) and Machinery & Transport Equipment (0.5%) indices were partially moderated by decreases led by the Crude Materials (-1.3%) and Chemicals & Chemical Products (-0.4%) indices.

#### Year-on-Year Change



The Export Price Index rose 2.5% in February 2019 over the previous year, after the 0.8% increase in January 2019. The Oil and Non-oil indices rose 3.7% and 2.2% respectively.

For the Non-oil sub-indices, increases observed in the Beverages & Tobacco (4.4%), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (3.5%), Machinery & Transport Equipment (3.4%) and Food & Live Animals (0.8%) indices were partially offset by decreases in the Animal & Vegetable Oils (-3.1%), Chemicals & Chemical Products (-1.5%), Manufactured Goods (-0.5%) and Crude Materials (-0.1%) indices.

#### **Technical Note**

The **Import Price Index (IPI)** is used primarily as an indicator to track the price trends of imported goods into Singapore. Prices of imports, valued at cif (cost, insurance and freight) are obtained monthly from major importers. The weighting pattern of the index is derived from import statistics for 2018.

The **Export Price Index (EPI)** measures changes in the price of all exports of merchandise from Singapore, including re-exports. In general, prices are obtained from major exporters of the selected commodities. Prices used in the index computation, are the prices of goods that physically leave Singapore's main ports of export; also termed as free on board prices. The weights of the index are derived from the distribution of export by commodity in 2018.

#### 2018 Rebasing of the IPI and EPI

The Singapore Department of Statistics (DOS) has completed the rebasing of the Import and Export Price Indices from base year 2012 to 2018. The rebasing exercise is conducted periodically to ensure that the 'basket' of commodities remain relevant to changing imports and exports patterns.

#### **Index Formula**

The 2018-based series is compiled using the Laspeyres formula where the price and weight reference periods are aligned to the year 2018. The geometric mean formula has been adopted in the computation of unweighted elementary aggregate price indices. The arithmetic mean formula is applied in compiling indices at higher levels of aggregation where weights of specific sub-indices are available.

#### **Measurement of Changes in Price Indices**

Change over previous month compares the index of the month with that of the preceding month. Such comparisons measure the change in the price index between two consecutive months. They serve as useful short-term indicators of the price movements.

Change over same period of previous year measures change in the index over a twelve-month period. Such comparisons compare the movement in the price index between similar months in two consecutive years.

#### **Index Revision**

The indices may be revised when late returns and amendments received from respondents are incorporated.






#### **Chart 1: Index**



#### **Chart 2: Month-on-month Change**




#### **Chart 3: Year-on-year Change**




#### **Chart 4: Index**
