#### **June 2018**

## **Import Price Index**

## Change over previous month


The Import Price Index rose 0.5 per cent in June 2018, extending the 3.8 per cent increase in May 2018. The Oil index increased 0.7 per cent, lower than the 11.6 per cent increase in the previous month. The Non-oil index rose 0.4 per cent in June 2018, following the 1.2 per cent increase in May.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, increases were led by the Chemicals & Chemical Products (1.0 per cent) due mainly to pricier polyethylene and the Machinery & Transport Equipment (0.3 per cent) index. The increases were partially offset by the decline in the Animal & Vegetable Oils (-2.2 per cent) index.


## Change over same period of previous year

The Import Price Index rose 9.0 per cent in June 2018 from a year ago, following the 6.6 per cent increase in May 2018. The Oil index climbed 47.1 per cent while the Non-oil index declined 0.7 per cent.


For the Non-oil sub-indices, lower prices of Animal & Vegetable Oils (-9.7 per cent), Machinery & Transport Equipment (-2.4 per cent), Food & Live Animals (-1.8 per cent) and Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-1.7 per cent) were partially moderated by higher prices of Manufactured Goods (6.4 per cent), Chemicals & Chemical Products (5.7 per cent), Crude Materials (2.9 per cent) and Beverages & Tobacco (0.1 per cent).

## **June 2018**

## **Export Price Index**

## Change over previous month

The Export Price Index rose 0.7 per cent in June 2018, following the 2.7 per cent increase in May 2018. The Oil index rose 1.6 per cent, extending the 9.1 per cent increase in the previous month, due to higher prices of diesel fuel & fuel oil and motor spirit. The Non-oil index rose 0.4 per cent, after the 1.1 per cent increase in May 2018.

For the Non-oil sub-indices, increases led by Chemicals & Chemical Products (0.7 per cent) and Machinery & Transport Equipment (0.3 per cent) indices were partially offset by declines led by the Animal & Vegetable Oils (-0.6 per cent) and Crude Materials (-0.1 per cent) indices.


#### Change over same period of previous year

The Export Price Index increased 6.5 per cent in June 2018 over the previous year, following the 3.9 per cent increase in May 2018. The Oil index climbed 42.5 per cent while the Non-oil index fell 0.3 per cent.


Among the Non-oil sub-indices, declines in the Food & Live Animals (-2.5 per cent), Animal & Vegetable Oils (-2.4 per cent), Beverages & Tobacco (-2.3 per cent), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-1.8 per cent) and Machinery & Transport Equipment (-1.5 per cent) indices were partially moderated by increases in the Manufactured Goods (4.0 per cent), Chemicals & Chemical Products (3.9 per cent) and Crude Materials (3.0 per cent) indices.

### TECHNICAL NOTE

The *Import Price Index (IPI)* is used primarily as an indicator to track the price trends of imported goods into Singapore. Prices of imports, valued at cif (cost, insurance and freight) are obtained monthly from major importers. The weighting pattern of the index is derived from import statistics for 2012.

The *Export Price Index (EPI)* measures changes in the price of all exports of merchandise from Singapore, including re-exports. In general, prices are obtained from major exporters of the selected commodities. Prices used in the index computation, are the prices of goods that physically leave Singapore's main ports of export; also termed as free on board prices. The weights of the index are derived from the distribution of export by commodity in 2012.

#### **Index Formula**

The 2012-based series is compiled using the Laspeyres formula where the price and weight reference periods are aligned to the year 2012. The geometric mean (GM) formula has been adopted in the computation of unweighted elementary aggregate price indices. The arithmetic mean (AM) formula is applied in compiling indices at higher levels of aggregation where weights of specific sub-indices are available

### **Measurement of Changes in Price Indices**

**Change over previous month** compares the index of the month with that of the preceding month. Such comparisons measure the change in the price index between two consecutive months. They serve as useful short-term indicators of the price movements. As the price indices are found not to be seasonal, it is not necessary for seasonal adjustment to be carried out.

*Change over same period of previous year* measures change in the index over a twelve-month period. Such comparisons compare the movement in the price index between similar months in two consecutive years.

#### **Index Revision**

The indices may be revised when late returns and amendments received from respondents are incorporated.
