



Portfolio Investment Assets (End of Period)

2021

Singapore's portfolio investment assets increased 5.3% year-on-year to \$2,262 bil as at end 2021. The growth was largely attributed to the 13.1% increase in investments in foreign equity & investment fund shares, which more than offset the 2.3% decline in long term debt securities and the 17.3% decline in short term debt securities.

The top five investment destinations were the United States (US), China, Japan, India, and the Republic of Korea. Collectively, the top five destination economies accounted for slightly over half of Singapore's total portfolio investment assets.
