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

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Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index (2023 = 100) January 2026


Month-on-Month Change



The Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index fell 0.3% in January 2026, following the 1.4% decrease in December 2025. The Oil index slipped 0.7%, extending the 7.1% decline in the previous month. The Non-oil index fell 0.2% in January 2026, after the 0.5% decrease in December 2025.

The decrease in the Non-oil index was due to the Chemicals & Chemical Products index, attributed to lower prices of organic chemicals, as well as the Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles, Manufactured Goods and Animal & Vegetable Oils indices. The declines were partially offset by increases in the Machinery & Transport Equipment, Food & Live Animals and Crude Materials indices.

Year-on-Year Change




The Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index fell 4.9% in January 2026 from a year ago, following the 1.2% decrease in December 2025. The Oil and Non-oil indices fell 16.3% and 3.0% respectively.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, the decline was due to the Machinery & Transport Equipment index, led by lower prices of electrical machinery apparatus, as well as the Chemicals & Chemical Products, Manufactured Goods and Crude Materials indices. The decreases were partially moderated by gains in the Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles, Food & Live Animals, Animal & Vegetable Oils and Beverages & Tobacco indices.

Domestic Supply Price Index (2023 = 100) January 2026


Month-on-Month Change



The Domestic Supply Price Index fell 0.1% in January 2026, following the 1.6% decrease in December 2025. The Oil index slipped 0.2%, furthering the 5.8% decrease in the previous month. The Non-oil index was unchanged in January 2026, after the 0.3% decline in December 2025.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, the Chemicals & Chemical Products index, contributed by lower prices of organic chemicals, as well as the Food & Live Animals and Animal & Vegetable Oils indices declined. The decreases were offset by increases in the Manufactured Goods, Machinery & Transport Equipment, Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles, Crude Materials and Beverages & Tobacco indices.

Year-on-Year Change



The Domestic Supply Price Index fell 6.0% in January 2026 from a year ago, extending the 2.6% decrease in December 2025. The Oil and Non-oil indices fell 16.7% and 2.4% respectively.

The decrease in the Non-oil index was due to the Machinery & Transport Equipment index, led by lower prices of electrical machinery apparatus, as well as the Chemicals & Chemical Products, Food & Live Animals and Animal & Vegetable Oils indices. The decreases were partially moderated by gains in the Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles, Manufactured Goods, Crude Materials and Beverages & Tobacco indices.

Technical Note

The **Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index (SMPPPI)** monitors price changes of locally manufactured commodities. The weights of the index are derived from the distribution of local production by commodity in 2023. Ex-factory prices are obtained from principal manufacturers of the items concerned.

The **Domestic Supply Price Index (DSPI)** is designed to measure the changes in the price level of either goods manufactured locally or imported, which are retained for use in the domestic economy by the government, business or household sectors. For imported products, the prices refer to those paid by importers in bringing the goods into Singapore, commonly referred to as c.i.f. prices. In the case of Singapore manufactured products, the quotations used are ex-factory prices. The weight for each commodity item is proportional to the value of its total supply or availability in the domestic market in 2023.

Index Formula

The 2023-based series is compiled using the 'modified Laspeyres' formula where the weight reference period of 2022 preceded the price reference period of 2023. The geometric mean formula has been adopted in the computation of unweighted elementary aggregate price indices. The arithmetic mean formula is applied in compiling indices at higher levels of aggregation where weights of specific sub-indices are available.

Measurement of Changes in Price Indices

Change over previous month compares the index of the month with that of the preceding month. Such comparisons measure the change in the price index between two consecutive months. They serve as useful short-term indicators of the price movements.

Change over same period of previous year measures change in the index over a twelve-month period. Such comparisons compare the movement in the price index between similar months in two consecutive years.

Linking the Old 2018-Based Price Index Series to the New 2023-Based Price Index Series

The SMPPPI and DSPI have been rebased from base year 2018 to base year 2023. To facilitate comparison of the historical price indices across base years, the old 2018-based series are linked to the new 2023-based series by re-scaling them via a Linked Coefficient. The Linked Coefficient is the ratio of the annual 2023-based index in 2023 to the annual 2018-based index in 2023.

Example: Linking the old Iron & Steel Index series for SMPPPI prior to 2023, to the 2023-based Iron & Steel Index (2023=100)

1) Calculate the linked coefficient

Year	Iron & Steel Index (2018=100)	Iron & Steel Index (2023=100)	Linked Coefficient
2023	135.6	100.0	$100.0 \div 135.6 = 0.737$

2) Re-scaling the old series to the 2023-based series using the Linked Coefficient

Year	Month	Iron & Steel Index (2018=100)	Iron & Steel Index (2023=100)
2021	Dec	125.6	$125.6 \times 0.737 = 92.6$
2022	Jan	127.2	$127.2 \times 0.737 = 93.7$

Rescaling the 2023-Based Index Series to Previous Years

To continue the old 2018-based index series going forward in time, re-scale the new 2023-based index series to the old base year 2018 level, via a Rescaling Coefficient. The Rescaling Coefficient is the ratio of the annual 2023-based index in 2023 to the annual 2023-based index in 2018.

Example: Rescaling the new 2023-based Iron & Steel Index series for SMPPI to the 2018-based Iron & Steel Index (2018=100)

1) Calculate the rescaling coefficient

Year	Annual Iron & Steel Index in 2023	Annual Iron & Steel Index in 2018	Rescaling Coefficient
2023	100.0	73.7	$100.0 \div 73.7 = 1.357$

2) Re-scaling the new series to the 2018-based series using the Rescaling Coefficient

Year	Month	Iron & Steel Index (2023=100)	Iron & Steel Index (2018=100)
2024	Jan	100.0	$100.0 \times 1.357 = 135.7$
2024	Feb	100.6	$100.6 \times 1.357 = 136.5$




Index Revision

Domestic Supply Price Index (2023 = 100) January 2026




