

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Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index (2023 = 100) April 2024


Month-on-Month Change



The Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index rose 0.3% in April 2024, following the 0.3% increase in March 2024. The Oil index gained 0.5%, continuing the 1.7% increase in the previous month. The Non-oil index increased 0.3% in April 2024, after the 0.1% increase in March 2024.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, the increases were led by the Machinery & Transport Equipment (0.5%) and the Chemicals & Chemical Products (0.3%) indices. The increases were partially moderated by the decreases in the Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-0.9%) index.

Year-on-Year Change




The Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index rose 3.2% in April 2024 from a year ago, following the 2.3% increase in March 2024. The Oil and Non-oil indices increased 5.4% and 2.8% respectively.

For the Non-oil sub-indices, the higher prices of Machinery & Transport Equipment (5.2%) and Food & Live Animals (2.7%) were partially offset by lower prices of Animal & Vegetable Oils (-12.5%), Crude Materials (-2.8%), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-2.3%), Beverages & Tobacco (-1.3%), Manufactured Goods (-1.3%), and Chemicals & Chemical Products (-1.0%).

Domestic Supply Price Index (2023 = 100) April 2024


Month-on-Month Change



The Domestic Supply Price Index rose 1.8% in April 2024, in contrast to the 0.4% decrease in March 2024. The Oil index gained 2.6%, extending the 3.4% increase in the previous month. The Non-oil index increased 1.6% in April 2024, after the 1.4% decrease in March 2024.

Increases of the Non-oil sub-indices were mainly due to Machinery & Transport Equipment (2.2%), led by higher prices of electrical machinery apparatus. The increases were partially offset by decreases in Crude Materials (-1.3%), attributed to lower prices of metalliferous ores and metal scrap.

Year-on-Year Change



The Domestic Supply Price Index fell 0.1% in April 2024 from a year ago, following the 2.0% decrease in March 2024. The Oil index increased 6.8% while the Non-oil index decreased 1.7%.

For the Non-oil sub-indices, lower prices of Animal & Vegetable Oils (-12.2%), Manufactured Goods (-3.0%), Crude Materials (-2.8%), Chemicals & Chemical Products (-2.3%), Machinery & Transport Equipment (-1.6%), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-1.4%), and Beverages & Tobacco (-1.3%) were partially offset by higher prices of Food & Live Animals (2.0%).

Technical Note

The **Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index (SMPPI)** monitors price changes of locally manufactured commodities. The weights of the index are derived from the distribution of local production by commodity in 2023. Ex-factory prices are obtained from principal manufacturers of the items concerned.

The **Domestic Supply Price Index (DSPI)** is designed to measure the changes in the price level of goods manufactured locally or imported which are retained for use in the domestic economy by the government, business or household sectors. For imported products, the prices refer to those paid by importers in bringing the goods into Singapore, commonly referred to as c.i.f. prices. In the case of Singapore manufactured products, the quotations used are ex-factory prices. The weight for each commodity item is proportional to the value of its total supply or availability in the domestic market in 2023.

Index Formula

The 2023-based series is compiled using the 'modified Laspeyres' formula where the weight reference period of 2022 preceded the price reference period of 2023. The geometric mean formula has been adopted in the computation of unweighted elementary aggregate price indices. The arithmetic mean formula is applied in compiling indices at higher levels of aggregation where weights of specific sub-indices are available.

Measurement of Changes in Price Indices

Change over previous month compares the index of the month with that of the preceding month. Such comparisons measure the change in the price index between two consecutive months. They serve as useful short-term indicators of the price movements.

Change over same period of previous year measures change in the index over a twelve-month period. Such comparisons compare the movement in the price index between similar months in two consecutive years.

Linking the Old 2018-Based Price Index Series to the New 2023-Based Price Index Series

The SMPPI and DSPI have been rebased from base year 2018 to base year 2023. To facilitate comparison of the historical price indices across base years, the old 2018-based series are linked to the new 2023-based series by re-scaling them via a Linked Coefficient. The Linked Coefficient is the ratio of the annual 2023-based index in 2023 to the annual 2018-based index in 2023.

Example: Linking the old Iron & Steel Index series for SMPPI prior to 2023, to the 2023-based Iron & Steel Index (2023=100)

1) Calculate the linked coefficient

Year	Iron & Steel Index (2018=100)	Iron & Steel Index (2023=100)	Linked Coefficient		
2023	135.6	100.0	100.0 ÷ 135.6 = 0.737		

2) Re-scaling the old series to the 2023-based series using the Linked Coefficient

Rescaling the 2023-Based Index Series to Previous Years

To continue the old 2018-based index series going forward in time, re-scale the new 2023-based index series to the old base year 2018 level, via a Rescaling Coefficient. The Rescaling Coefficient is the ratio of the annual 2023-based index in 2023 to the annual 2023-based index in 2018.

Example: Rescaling the new 2023-based Iron & Steel Index series for SMPPI to the 2018-based Iron & Steel Index (2018=100)

1) Calculate the linked coefficient

Year	Annual Iron & Steel Index in 2023	Annual Iron & Steel Index in 2018	Linked Coefficient

2) Re-scaling the new series to the 2018-based series using the Linked Coefficient


Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index (2023 = 100) April 2024








Domestic Supply Price Index (2023 = 100) April 2024






