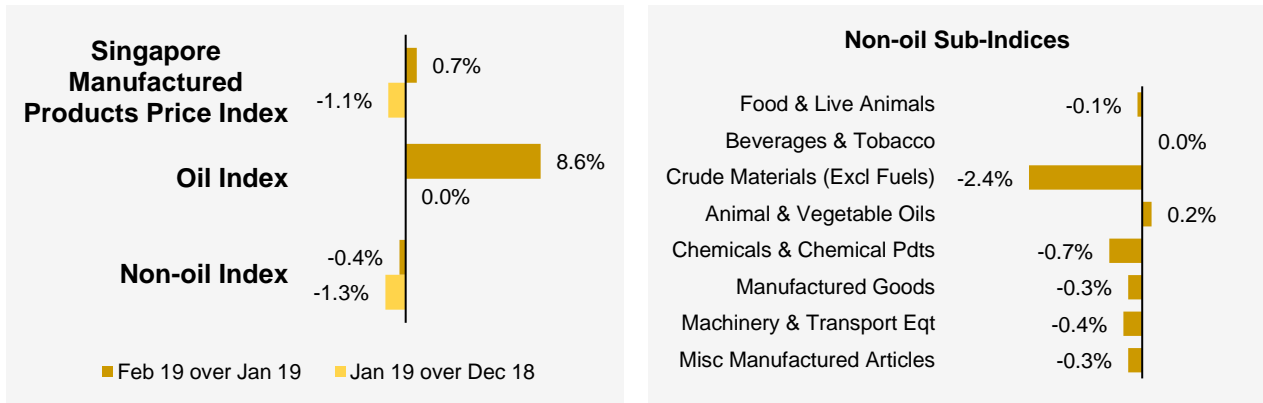
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# Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index (2018 = 100) February 2019

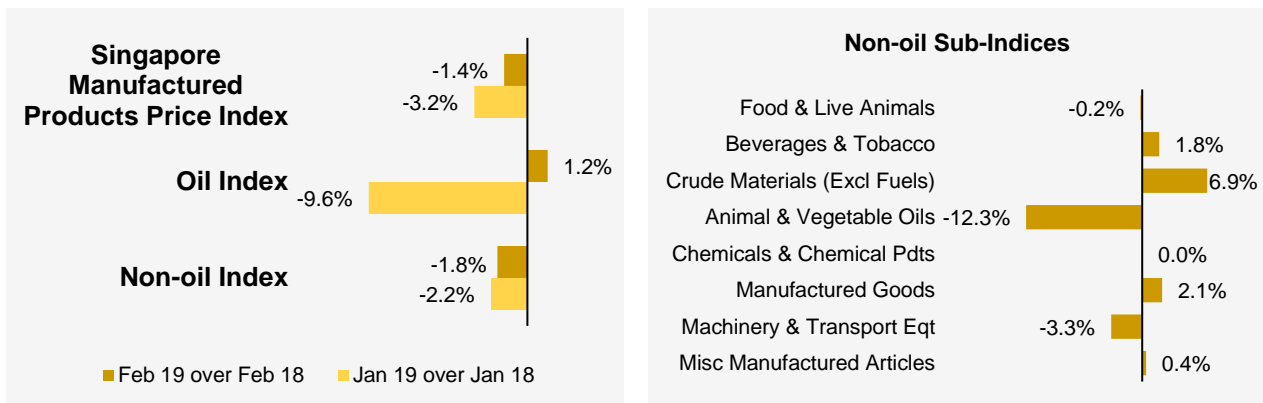
## Month-on-Month Change



The Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index rose 0.7% in February 2019, in contrast to the 1.1% decrease in January 2019. The Oil index increased 8.6%, after remaining unchanged in the previous month. The Non-oil index fell 0.4% in February 2019, following the 1.3% decrease in January 2019.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, decreases led by the Chemicals & Chemical Products (-0.7%), Machinery & Transport Equipment (-0.4%) and Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-0.3%) indices were partially moderated by the increase in the Animal & Vegetable Oils (0.2%) index.

## Year-on-Year Change

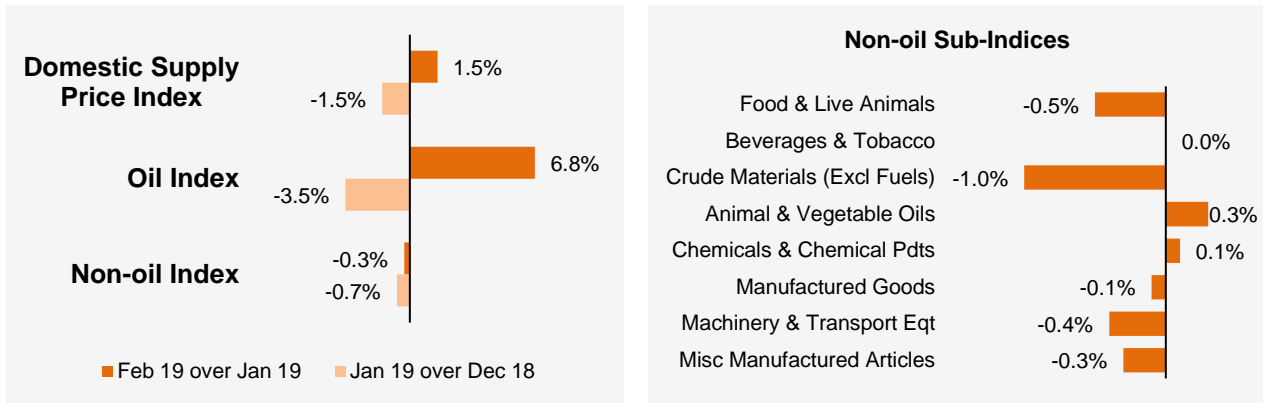


The Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index fell 1.4% in February 2019 from a year ago, following the 3.2% decrease in January 2019. The Oil index rose 1.2% while the Non-oil index decreased 1.8%.

For the Non-oil sub-indices, decreases in the Animal & Vegetable Oils (-12.3%), Machinery & Transport Equipment (-3.3%) and Food & Live Animals (-0.2%) indices were partially offset by increases in the Crude Materials (6.9%), Manufactured Goods (2.1%), Beverages & Tobacco (1.8%) and Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (0.4%) indices.

## Domestic Supply Price Index (2018 = 100) February 2019

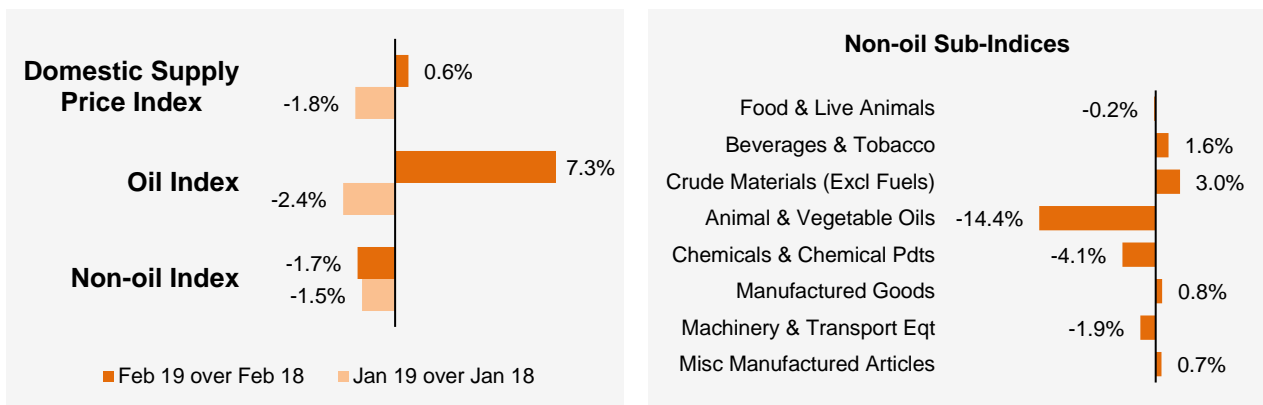
### Month-on-Month Change



The Domestic Supply Price Index rose 1.5% in February 2019, in contrast to the 1.5% decrease January 2019. The Oil index increased 6.8%, against the 3.5% decrease in the previous month. The Non-oil index decreased 0.3% in February 2019, after falling 0.7% in the previous month.

For the Non-oil sub-indices, decreases led by the Machinery & Transport Equipment (-0.4%) and Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-0.3%) indices were partially moderated by increases in the Animal & Vegetable Oils (0.3%) and Chemicals & Chemical Products (0.1%) indices.

### Year-on-Year Change



The Domestic Supply Price Index rose 0.6% in February 2019 over the previous year, in contrast to the 1.8% decrease in January 2019. The Oil index increased 7.3% while the Non-oil index fell 1.7%.

For the Non-oil sub-indices, decreases in the Animal & Vegetable Oils (-14.4%), Chemicals & Chemical Products (-4.1%), Machinery & Transport Equipment (-1.9%) and Food & Live Animals (-0.2%) indices were partially offset by increases in the Crude Materials (3.0%), Beverages & Tobacco (1.6%), Manufactured Goods (0.8%) and Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (0.7%) indices.

## Technical Note

The **Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index (SMPPI)** monitors price changes of locally manufactured commodities. The weights of the index are derived from the distribution of local production by commodity in 2018. Ex-factory prices are obtained from principal manufacturers of the items concerned.

The **Domestic Supply Price Index (DSPI)** is designed to measure the changes in the price level of goods manufactured locally or imported which are retained for use in the domestic economy by the government, business or household sectors. For imported products, the prices refer to those paid by importers in bringing the goods into Singapore, commonly referred to as c.i.f. prices. In the case of Singapore manufactured products, the quotations used are ex-factory prices. The weight for each commodity item is proportional to the value of its total supply or availability in the domestic market in 2018.

### 2018 Rebasing of the SMPPI and DSPI

The Singapore Department of Statistics (DOS) has completed the rebasing of the Singapore Manufactured Products and Domestic Supply Price Indices from base year 2012 to 2018. The rebasing exercise is conducted periodically to ensure that the 'basket' of commodities remain relevant to changing production and domestic supply patterns.

### Index Formula

The 2018-based series is compiled using the 'modified Laspeyres' formula where the weight reference period of 2017 preceded the price reference period of 2018. The geometric mean formula has been adopted in the computation of unweighted elementary aggregate price indices. The arithmetic mean formula is applied in compiling indices at higher levels of aggregation where weights of specific sub-indices are available.

### Measurement of Changes in Price Indices

*Change over previous month* compares the index of the month with that of the preceding month. Such comparisons measure the change in the price index between two consecutive months. They serve as useful short-term indicators of the price movements.

*Change over same period of previous year* measures change in the index over a twelve-month period. Such comparisons compare the movement in the price index between similar months in two consecutive years.

### **Index Revision**

The indices may be revised when late returns and amendments received from respondents are incorporated.

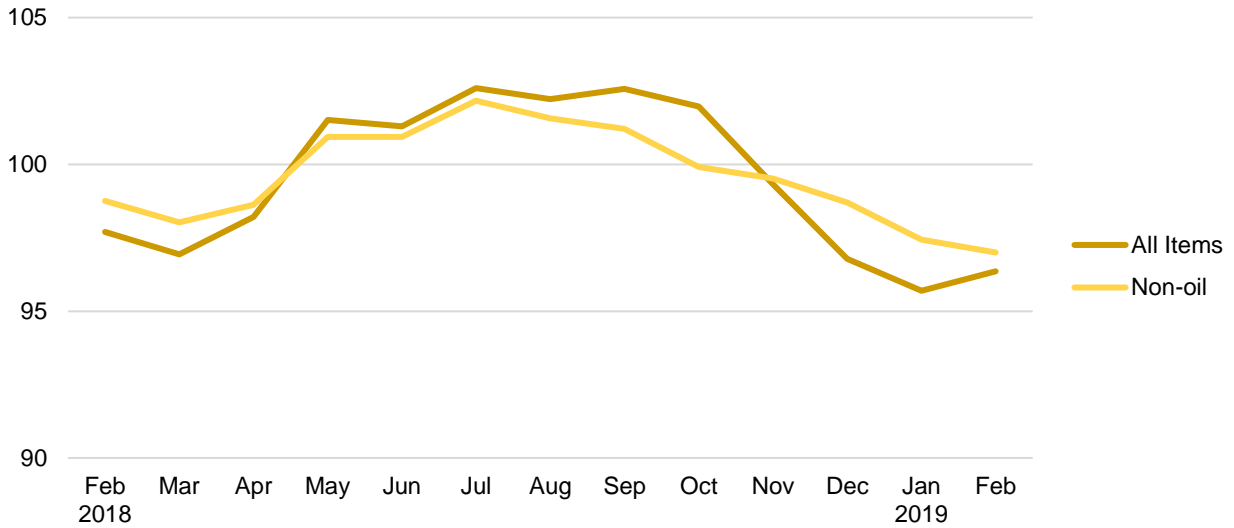

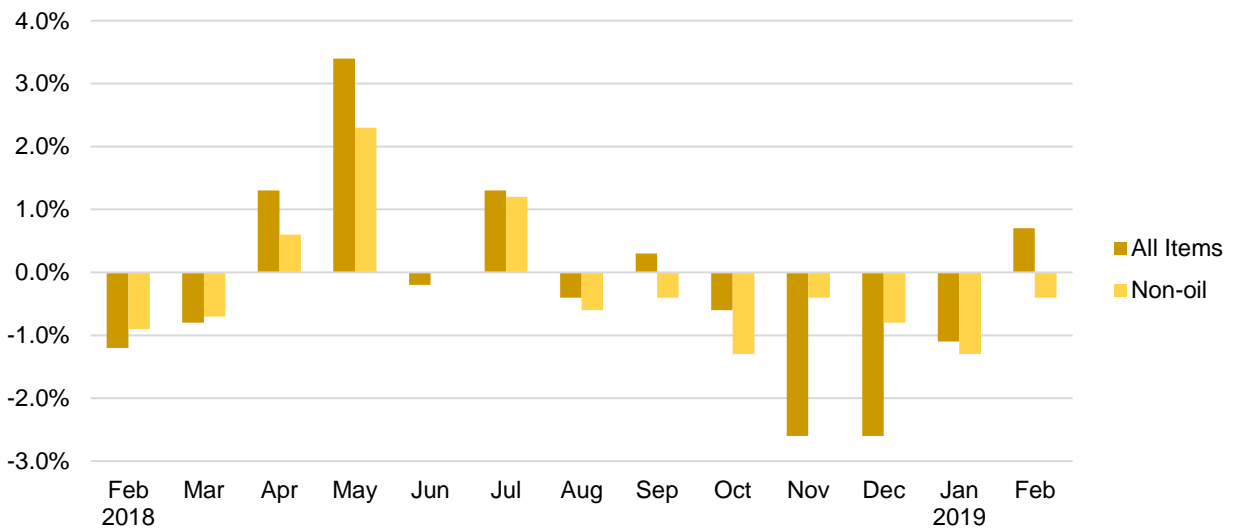

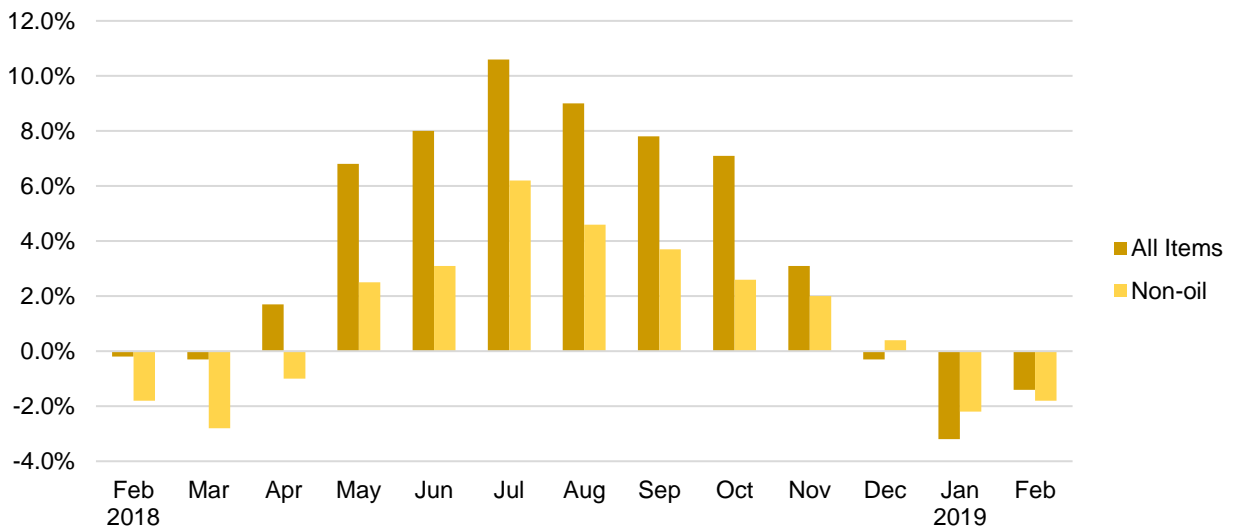
**Chart 1: Index**



**Chart 2: Month-on-month Change**

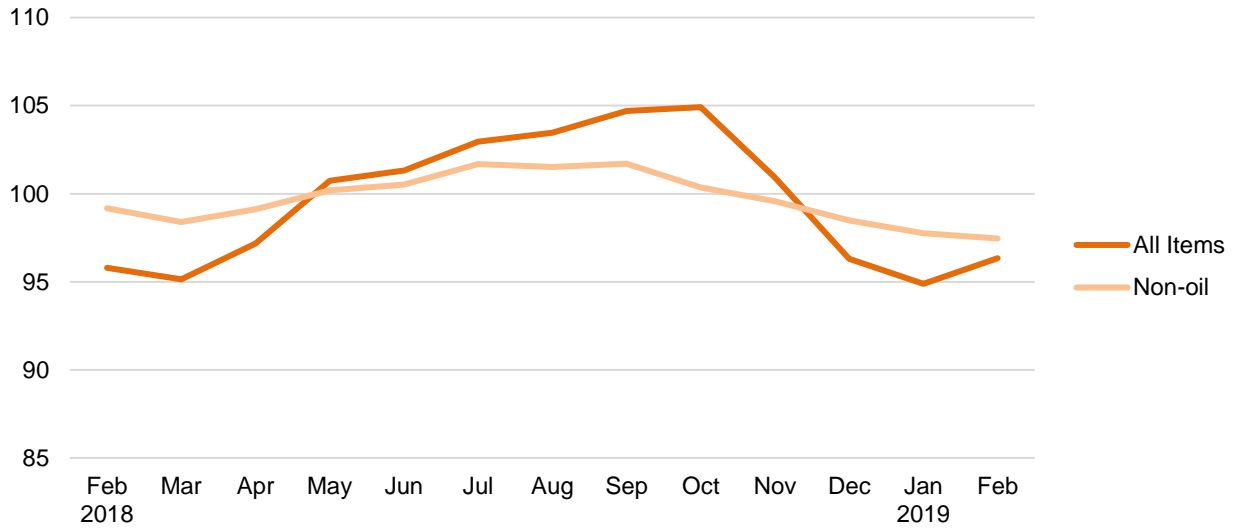


**Chart 3: Year-on-year Change**

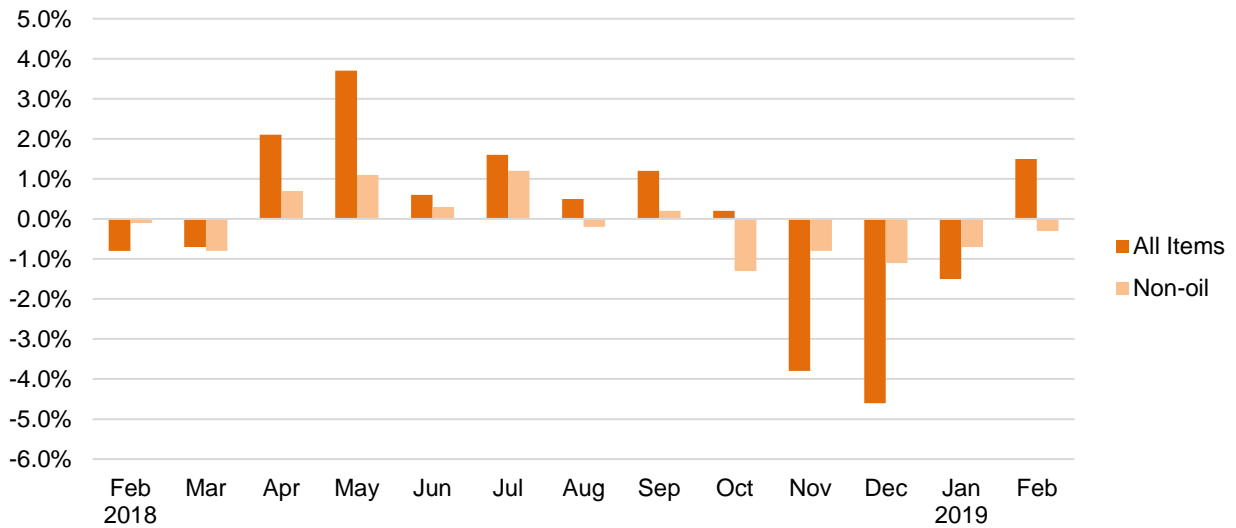

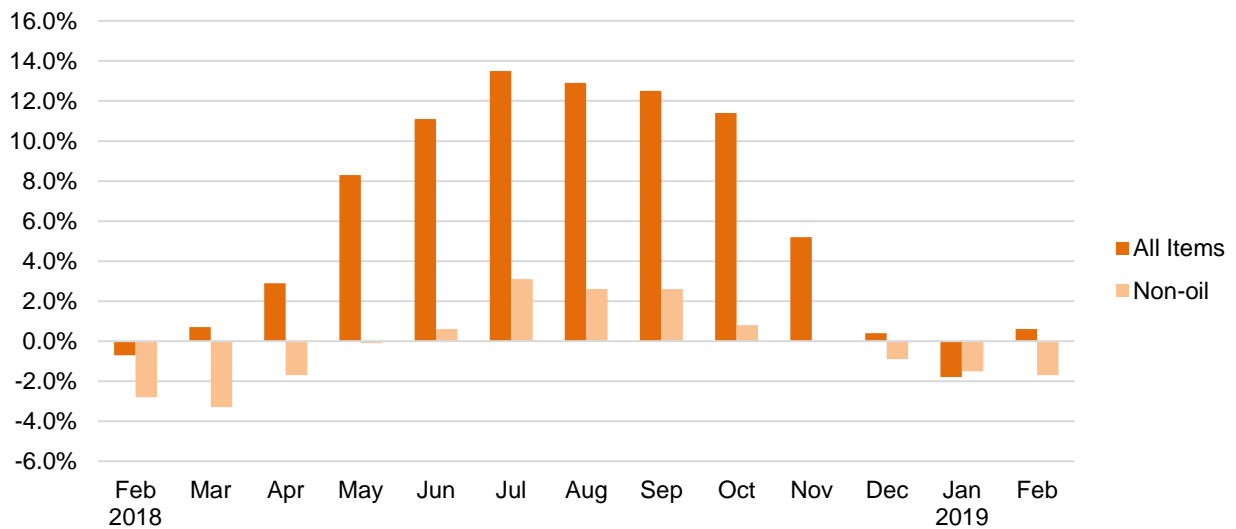
**Chart 4: Index**
