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### SINGAPORE MANUFACTURED PRODUCTS PRICE INDEX (2012 = 100)

#### **June 2018**

#### **Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index**

#### Change over previous month

The Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index fell 0.5 per cent in June 2018, in contrast to the 4.4 per cent increase in May 2018. The Oil index declined 2.3 per cent, reversing the 9.4 per cent increase in May 2018, due mainly to lower prices of power kerosene and motor spirit. The Non-oil index edged down 0.1 per cent in June 2018, against the 3.4 per cent increase in the previous month.

For the Non-oil sub-indices, the declines led by the Chemicals & Chemical Products (-2.8 per cent) index, due mainly to cheaper organic chemicals, and the Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-0.3 per cent) index were partially moderated by increases in the Machinery & Transport Equipment (1.9 per cent) and Manufactured Goods (0.5 per cent) indices.

#### Change over same period of previous year


The Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index increased 7.8 per cent in June 2018 over the previous year, after the 6.9 per cent increase in May 2018. The Oil and Non-Oil indices rose 37.0 per cent and 2.8 per cent respectively.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, higher prices of Chemicals & Chemical Products (12.5 per cent), Crude Materials (6.5 per cent), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (4.3 per cent), Manufactured Goods (3.9 per cent), Beverages & Tobacco (1.4 per cent) and Food & Live Animals (0.4 per cent) were partially moderated by lower prices of Animal & Vegetable Oils (-18.2 per cent) and Machinery & Transport Equipment (-2.9 per cent).

#### **June 2018**

#### **Domestic Supply Price Index**

#### Change over previous month

The Domestic Supply Price Index rose 0.7 per cent in June 2018, following the 4.3 per cent increase in the previous month. The Oil index edged up 0.3 per cent in June 2018, lower than the 11.3 per cent increase in May 2018. The Non-oil index increased 0.8 per cent, after climbing 1.4 per cent in the previous month.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, increases led by the Machinery & Transport Equipment (1.4 per cent) index due mainly to higher prices of integrated circuits and the Chemicals & Chemical Products (0.4 per cent) index were partially offset by decreases in the Animal & Vegetable Oils (-2.4 per cent) and Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-0.2 per cent) indices.

#### Change over same period of previous year

The Domestic Supply Price Index climbed 11.6 per cent in June 2018 over the previous year, compared to the 8.6 per cent increase in May 2018. The Oil and Non-Oil indices rose 47.1 per cent and 0.6 per cent respectively.


Among the Non-oil sub-indices, higher prices of Chemicals & Chemical Products (9.8 per cent), Manufactured Goods (5.3 per cent), Crude Materials (2.7 per cent) and Beverages & Tobacco (0.9 per cent) were partially offset by lower prices of Animal & Vegetable Oils (-9.5 per cent), Machinery & Transport Equipment (-2.5 per cent), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-1.9 per cent) and Food & Live Animals (-1.3 per cent).

# Domestic Supply Price Index (2012=100) — Overall — Non-oil 100 90 80 Jun Sep Dec Mar Jun



#### TECHNICAL NOTE

The *Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index (SMPPI)* monitors price changes of locally manufactured commodities. The weights of the index are derived from the distribution of local production by commodity in 2011. Ex-factory prices are obtained from principal manufacturers of the items concerned.

The *Domestic Supply Price Index (DSPI)* is designed to measure the changes in the price level of goods manufactured locally or imported which are retained for use in the domestic economy by the government, business or household sectors. For imported products, the prices refer to those paid by importers in bringing the goods into Singapore, commonly referred to as c.i.f. prices. In the case of Singapore manufactured products, the quotations used are ex-factory prices. The weight for each commodity item is proportional to the value of its total supply or availability in the domestic market in 2011.

#### **Index Formula**

The 2012-based series is compiled using the 'modified Laspeyres' formula where the weight reference period of 2011 preceded the price reference period of 2012. The geometric mean (GM) formula has been adopted in the computation of unweighted elementary aggregate price indices. The arithmetic mean (AM) formula is applied in compiling indices at higher levels of aggregation where weights of specific sub-indices are available.

#### **Measurement of Changes in Price Indices**

*Change over previous month* compares the index of the month with that of the preceding month. Such comparisons measure the change in the price index between two consecutive months. They serve as useful short-term indicators of the price movements. As the price indices are found not to be seasonal, it is not necessary for seasonal adjustment to be carried out.

*Change over same period of previous year* measures change in the index over a twelve-month period. Such comparisons compare the movement in the price index between similar months in two consecutive years.

#### **Index Revision**

The indices may be revised when late returns and amendments received from respondents are incorporated.
