Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index

Change over previous month

The Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index rose 2.4 per cent in May 2018, in contrast to the 1.9 per cent decrease in April 2018. The Oil index rose 9.2 per cent following the 6.0 per cent increase in April 2018, due mainly to higher prices of diesel fuel & fuel oils and power kerosene. The Non-oil index went up 1.0 per cent in May 2018, against the 3.4 per cent decrease in the previous month.

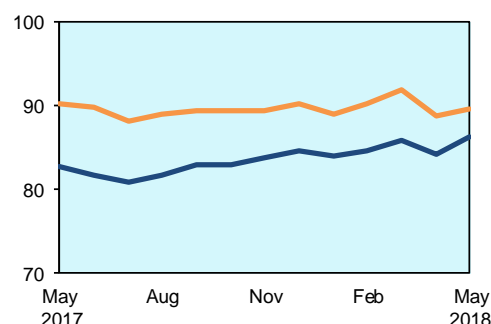
For the Non-oil sub-indices, the increases led by the Chemicals & Chemical Products (1.3 per cent) index, due mainly to pricier propene, and the Machinery & Transport Equipment (0.9 per cent) index were partially moderated by the decrease in the Animal & Vegetable Oils (-0.8 per cent) index.

Change over same period of previous year

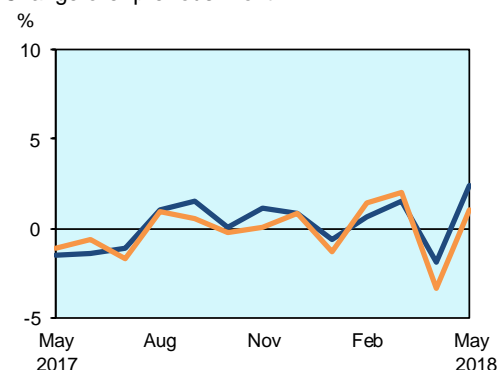
The Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index increased 4.2 per cent in May 2018 over the previous year, after the 0.2 per cent increase in April 2018. The Oil index rose 32.3 per cent while the Non-oil index fell 0.8 per cent.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, lower prices of Animal & Vegetable Oils (-13.2 per cent), Machinery & Transport Equipment (-5.0 per cent) and Food & Live Animals (-0.1 per cent) were partially moderated by higher prices of Crude Materials (6.6 per cent), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (4.2 per cent), Chemicals & Chemical Products (3.8 per cent), Manufactured Goods (3.2 per cent) and Beverages & Tobacco (1.4 per cent).

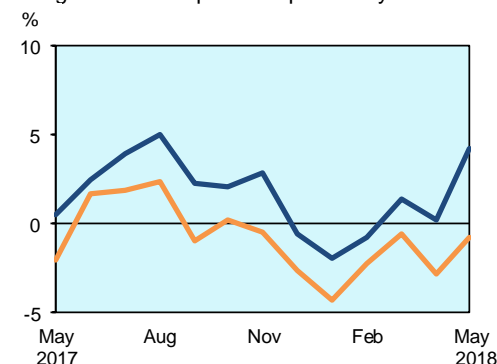

Domestic Supply Price Index

Change over previous month

The Domestic Supply Price Index rose 4.0 per cent in May 2018, following the 1.5 per cent increase in the previous month. The Oil index went up 11.6 per cent in May 2018, attributed mainly to higher prices of diesel fuel & fuel oils and crude petroleum, after the 5.8 per cent increase in April 2018. The Non-oil index increased 0.9 per cent, in contrast to the 0.2 per cent decline in the previous month.

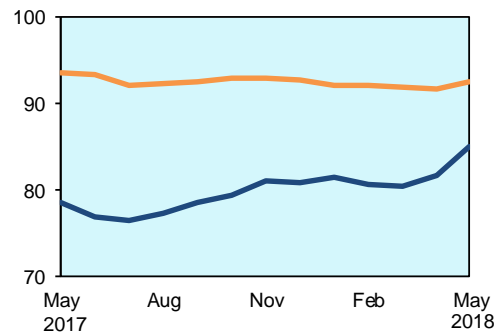
Among the Non-oil sub-indices, increases led by the Chemicals & Chemical Products (1.4 per cent) index, due mainly to higher prices of propene, and the Machinery & Transport Equipment (0.8 per cent) index were partially offset by the decrease in the Animal & Vegetable Oils (-0.1 per cent) index.

Change over same period of previous year

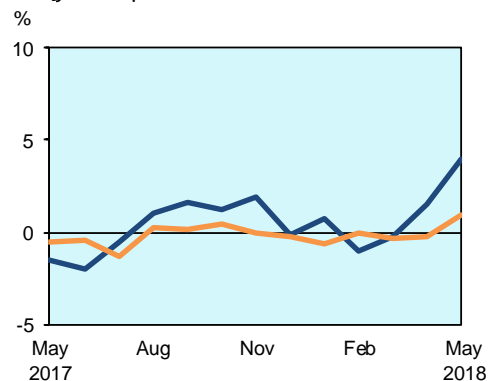
The Domestic Supply Price Index climbed 8.2 per cent in May 2018 over the previous year, compared to the 2.5 per cent increase in April 2018. The Oil index rose 36.7 per cent while the Non-oil index fell 1.2 per cent.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, lower prices of Animal & Vegetable Oils (-10.0 per cent), Machinery & Transport Equipment (-3.7 per cent), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-1.8 per cent) and Food & Live Animals (-1.7 per cent) were partially offset by higher prices of Manufactured Goods (4.2 per cent), Chemicals & Chemical Products (3.5 per cent), Crude Materials (2.0 per cent) and Beverages & Tobacco (0.8 per cent).

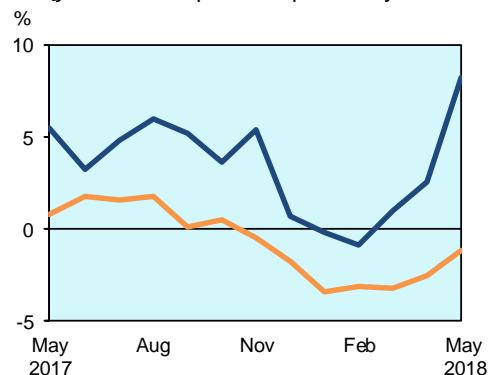
Domestic Supply Price Index (2012=100) — Overall — Non-oil

TECHNICAL NOTE

The *Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index (SMPPI)* monitors price changes of locally manufactured commodities. The weights of the index are derived from the distribution of local production by commodity in 2011. Ex-factory prices are obtained from principal manufacturers of the items concerned.

The *Domestic Supply Price Index (DSPI)* is designed to measure the changes in the price level of goods manufactured locally or imported which are retained for use in the domestic economy by the government, business or household sectors. For imported products, the prices refer to those paid by importers in bringing the goods into Singapore, commonly referred to as c.i.f. prices. In the case of Singapore manufactured products, the quotations used are ex-factory prices. The weight for each commodity item is proportional to the value of its total supply or availability in the domestic market in 2011.

Index Formula

The 2012-based series is compiled using the 'modified Laspeyres' formula where the weight reference period of 2011 preceded the price reference period of 2012. The geometric mean (GM) formula has been adopted in the computation of unweighted elementary aggregate price indices. The arithmetic mean (AM) formula is applied in compiling indices at higher levels of aggregation where weights of specific sub-indices are available.

Measurement of Changes in Price Indices

Change over previous month compares the index of the month with that of the preceding month. Such comparisons measure the change in the price index between two consecutive months. They serve as useful short-term indicators of the price movements. As the price indices are found not to be seasonal, it is not necessary for seasonal adjustment to be carried out.

Change over same period of previous year measures change in the index over a twelve-month period. Such comparisons compare the movement in the price index between similar months in two consecutive years.
