Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index

Change over previous month

The Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index fell 2.8 per cent in November 2018, in contrast to the 0.7 per cent increase in October 2018. The Oil index slid 14.8 per cent, reversing the 3.2 per cent gain in October 2018, due mainly to lower prices of diesel fuel & fuel oil and power kerosene. The Non-oil index increased 0.2 per cent in November 2018, while it was unchanged in October 2018.

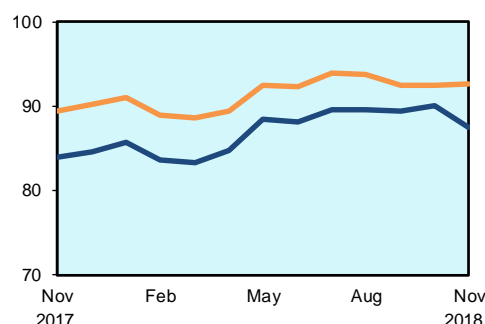
Among the Non-oil sub-indices, increases led by the Chemicals & Chemical Products (1.3 per cent) index, due mainly to higher prices of organic chemicals, and the Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (0.1 per cent) index were partially moderated by decreases in the Animal & Vegetable Oils (-1.8 per cent) and Machinery & Transport Equipment (-0.4 per cent) indices.

Change over same period of previous year

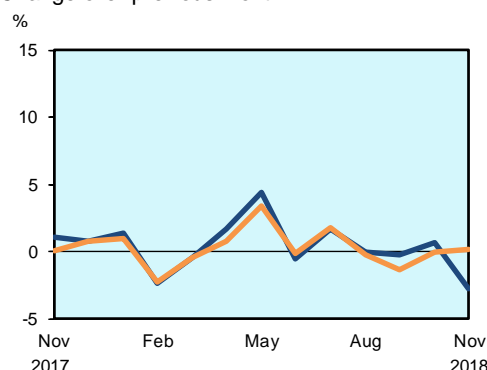
The Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index increased 4.3 per cent in November 2018 over the previous year, following the 8.5 per cent increase in October 2018. The Oil and Non-Oil indices rose 7.6 per cent and 3.6 per cent respectively.

For the Non-oil sub-indices, higher prices of Chemicals & Chemical Products (10.5 per cent), Crude Materials (4.7 per cent), Beverages & Tobacco (2.9 per cent), Food & Live Animals (1.8 per cent), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (1.5 per cent), Manufactured Goods (0.9 per cent) and Machinery & Transport Equipment (0.5 per cent) were partially offset by lower prices of Animal & Vegetable Oils (-20.5 per cent).

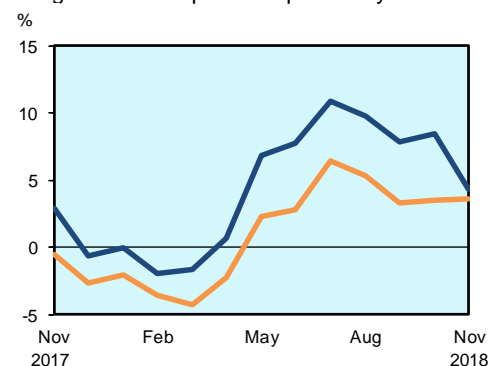
Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index (2012=100)

Domestic Supply Price Index

Change over previous month

The Domestic Supply Price Index declined 5.0 per cent in November 2018, compared to the 1.8 per cent increase in the previous month. The Oil index decreased 13.3 per cent, reversing the 5.4 per cent increase in October 2018, due mainly to lower prices of crude petroleum and diesel fuel & fuel oil. The Non-oil index declined 0.8 per cent in November 2018, while it was unchanged in October 2018.

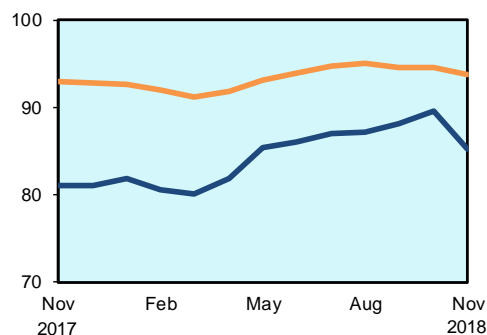
Among the Non-oil sub-indices, declines were led by the Chemicals & Chemical Products (-2.0 per cent) index, due mainly to lower prices of organic chemicals, and the Machinery & Transport Equipment (-0.5 per cent) index. The 0.2 per cent increase in the Beverages & Tobacco index partially offset the decreases.

Change over same period of previous year

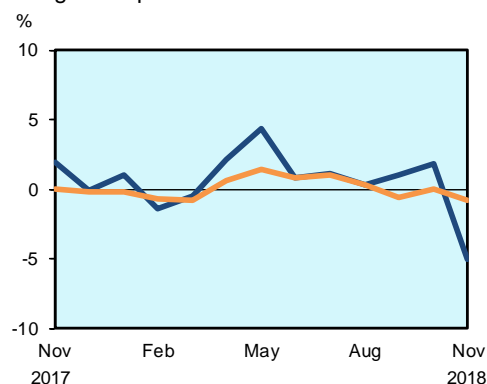
The Domestic Supply Price Index rose 5.1 per cent in November 2018 over the previous year, following the 12.7 per cent increase in October 2018. The Oil and Non-Oil indices increased 16.0 per cent and 1.0 per cent respectively in November 2018.

Among the Non-oil sub-indices, increases in the Chemicals & Chemical Products (5.0 per cent), Manufactured Goods (2.3 per cent), Beverages & Tobacco (2.1 per cent) and Crude Materials (0.2 per cent) indices were partially moderated by decreases in the Animal & Vegetable Oils (-18.2 per cent), Machinery & Transport Equipment (-0.1 per cent), Food & Live Animals (-0.1 per cent) and Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-0.1 per cent) indices.

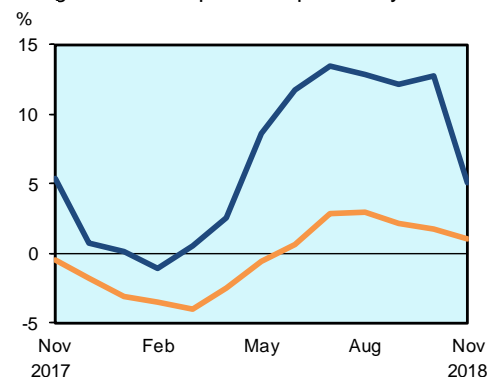
Domestic Supply Price Index (2012=100) — Overall — Non-oil

TECHNICAL NOTE

The *Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index (SMPPPI)* monitors price changes of locally manufactured commodities. The weights of the index are derived from the distribution of local production by commodity in 2011. Ex-factory prices are obtained from principal manufacturers of the items concerned.

The *Domestic Supply Price Index (DSPI)* is designed to measure the changes in the price level of goods manufactured locally or imported which are retained for use in the domestic economy by the government, business or household sectors. For imported products, the prices refer to those paid by importers in bringing the goods into Singapore, commonly referred to as c.i.f. prices. In the case of Singapore manufactured products, the quotations used are ex-factory prices. The weight for each commodity item is proportional to the value of its total supply or availability in the domestic market in 2011.

Index Formula

The 2012-based series is compiled using the 'modified Laspeyres' formula where the weight reference period of 2011 preceded the price reference period of 2012. The geometric mean (GM) formula has been adopted in the computation of unweighted elementary aggregate price indices. The arithmetic mean (AM) formula is applied in compiling indices at higher levels of aggregation where weights of specific sub-indices are available.

Measurement of Changes in Price Indices

Change over previous month compares the index of the month with that of the preceding month. Such comparisons measure the change in the price index between two consecutive months. They serve as useful short-term indicators of the price movements.

Change over same period of previous year measures change in the index over a twelve-month period. Such comparisons compare the movement in the price index between similar months in two consecutive years.

Index Revision

The indices may be revised when late returns and amendments received from respondents are incorporated.
