




Life Expectancy at Birth in 2023 was 0.6 years higher than a decade ago and unchanged from 2022.





Data pertain to the life expectancy at birth of the resident population (i.e. Singapore citizens and permanent residents). Note: Data for 2023 are preliminary. Data for 2022 and 2023 have been affected by higher mortality rates, particularly those observed in 2022, arising from the COVID-19 pandemic. They may not accurately represent the number of years individuals can expect to live, if mortality rates return to pre-pandemic levels.

Life expectancy at birth is defined as the average number of years a new-born baby might expect to live, if he or she were to experience the age-specific mortality rates of the reference period throughout his or her life.
