

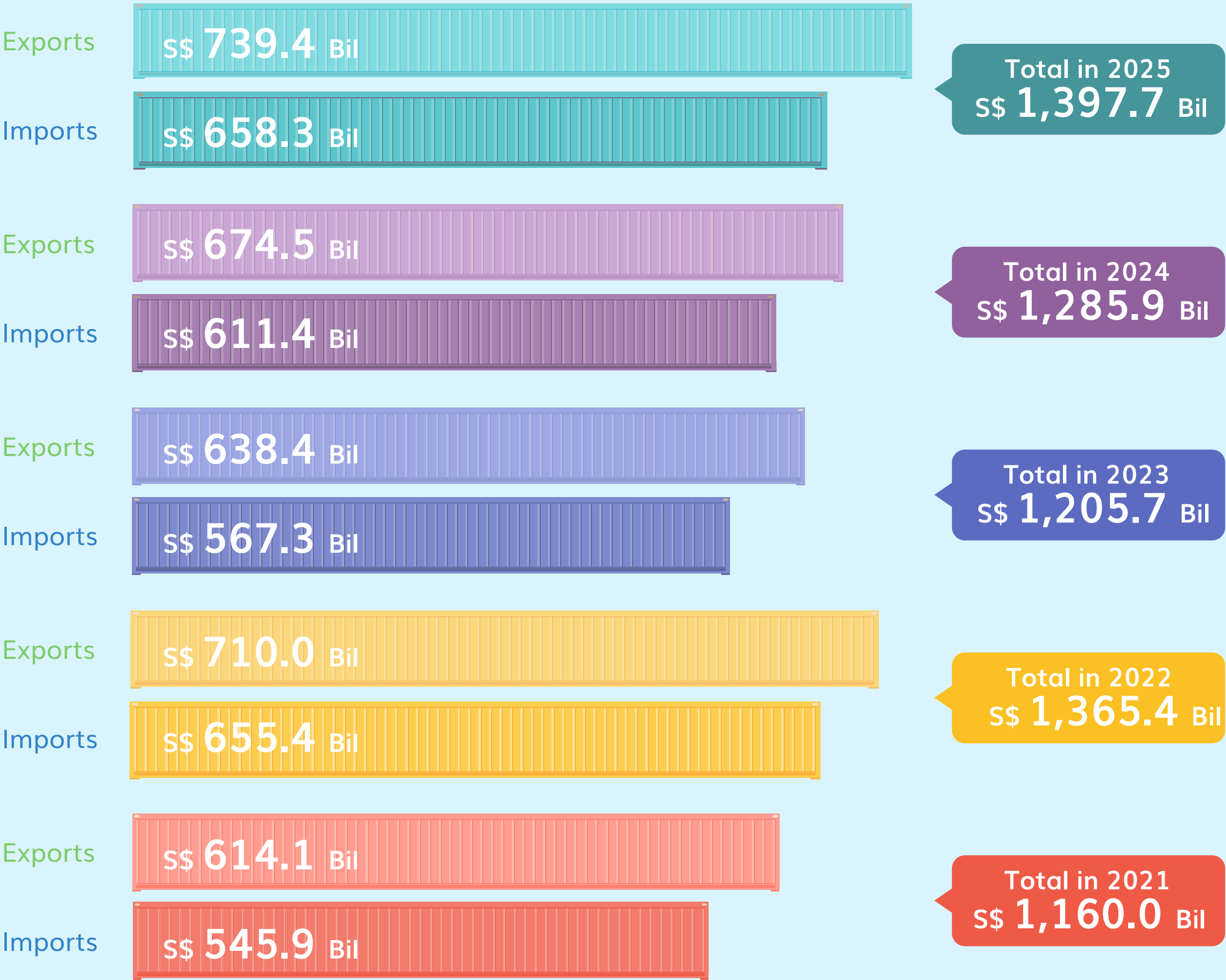

TOTAL MERCHANDISE TRADE AT CURRENT PRICES, 2021 - 2025

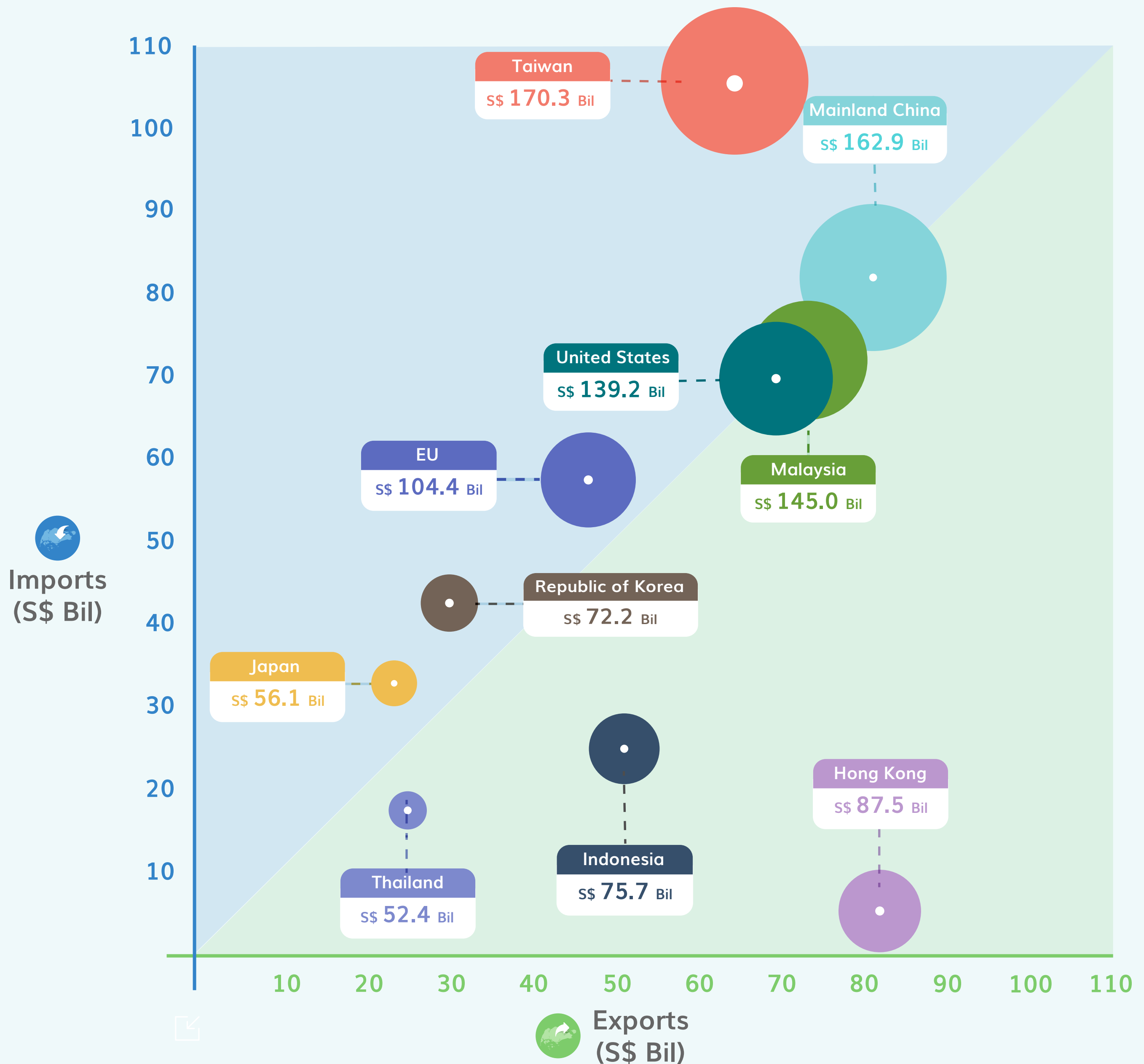

MERCHANDISE TRADE PERFORMANCE WITH MAJOR TRADING PARTNERS, 2025

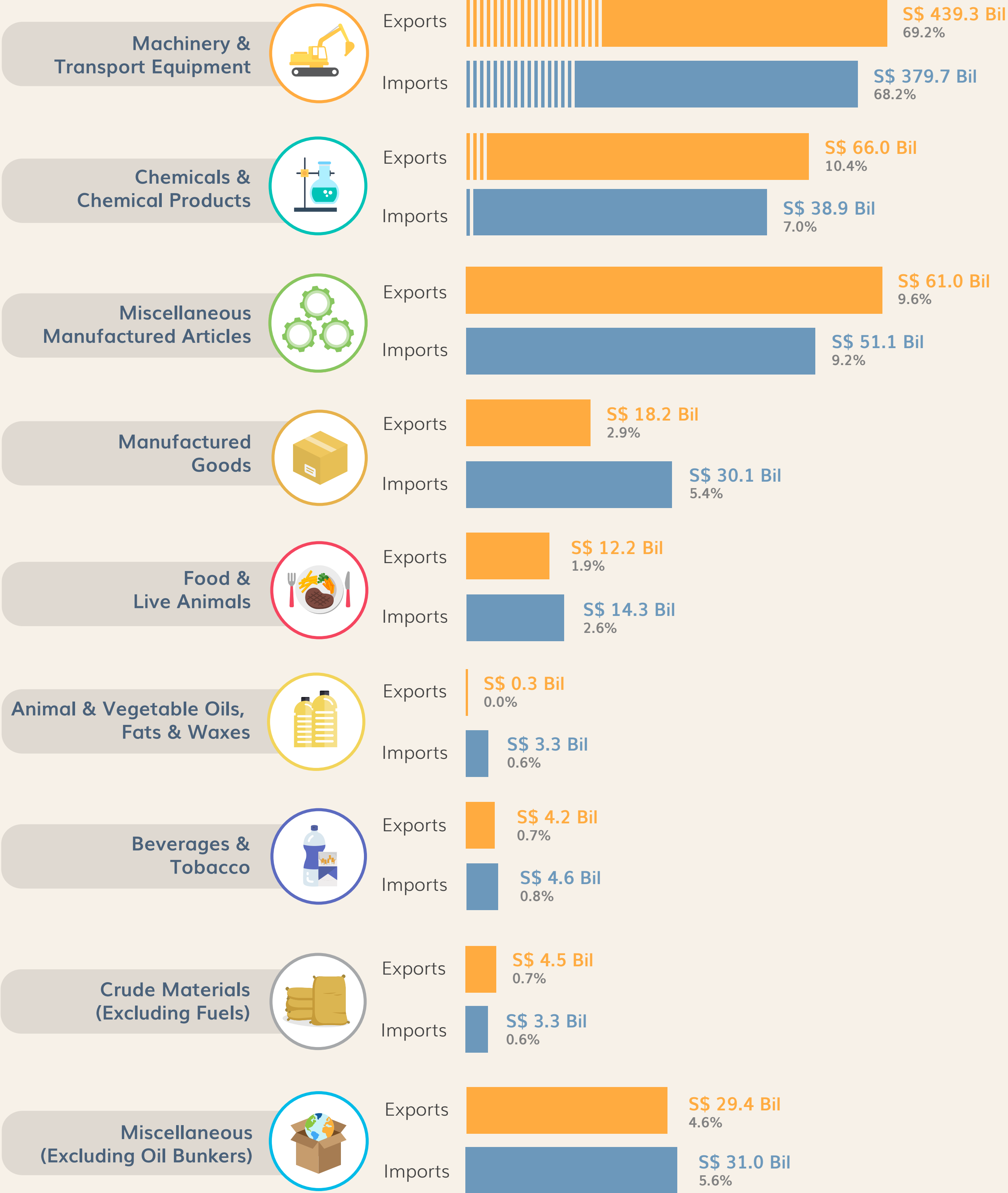


Note: The size of the bubbles reflects Singapore's total merchandise trade value with the trading partner. If the centre point (white circle) of the bubble falls in the blue region, it indicates that Singapore's imports from the trading partner exceeds Singapore's exports. If the centre point of the bubble falls in the green region, then Singapore's exports to the trading partner exceeds Singapore's imports.

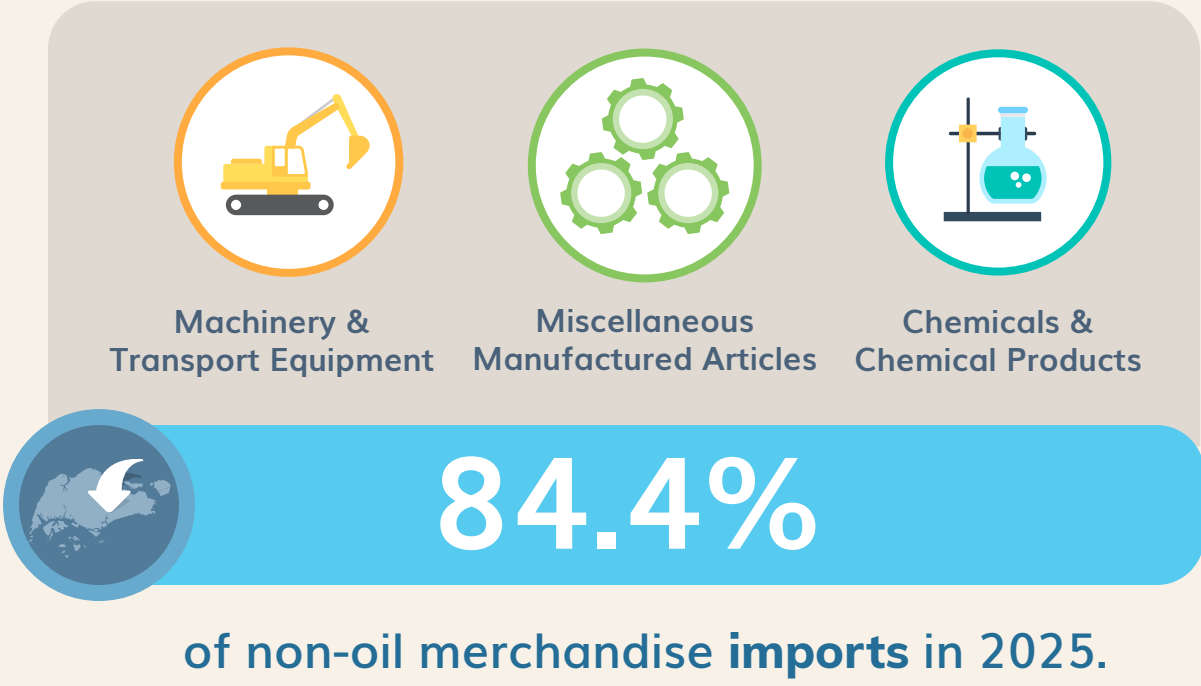
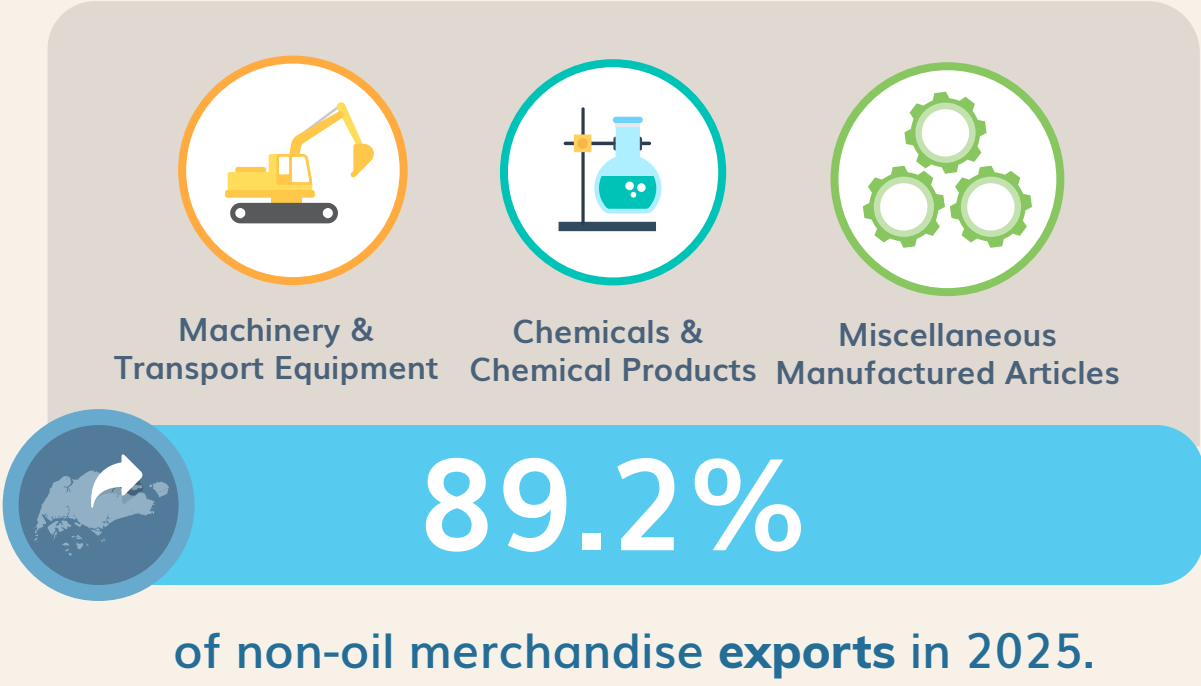


In 2025, Taiwan, Mainland China, Malaysia and the US were Singapore's top trading partners. Singapore's imports to Taiwan and Mainland China exceeded Singapore's exports to these two trading partners, while Singapore's imports from the US exceeded exports to the US.

NON-OIL MERCHANDISE TRADE BY MAJOR COMMODITY SECTIONS, 2025



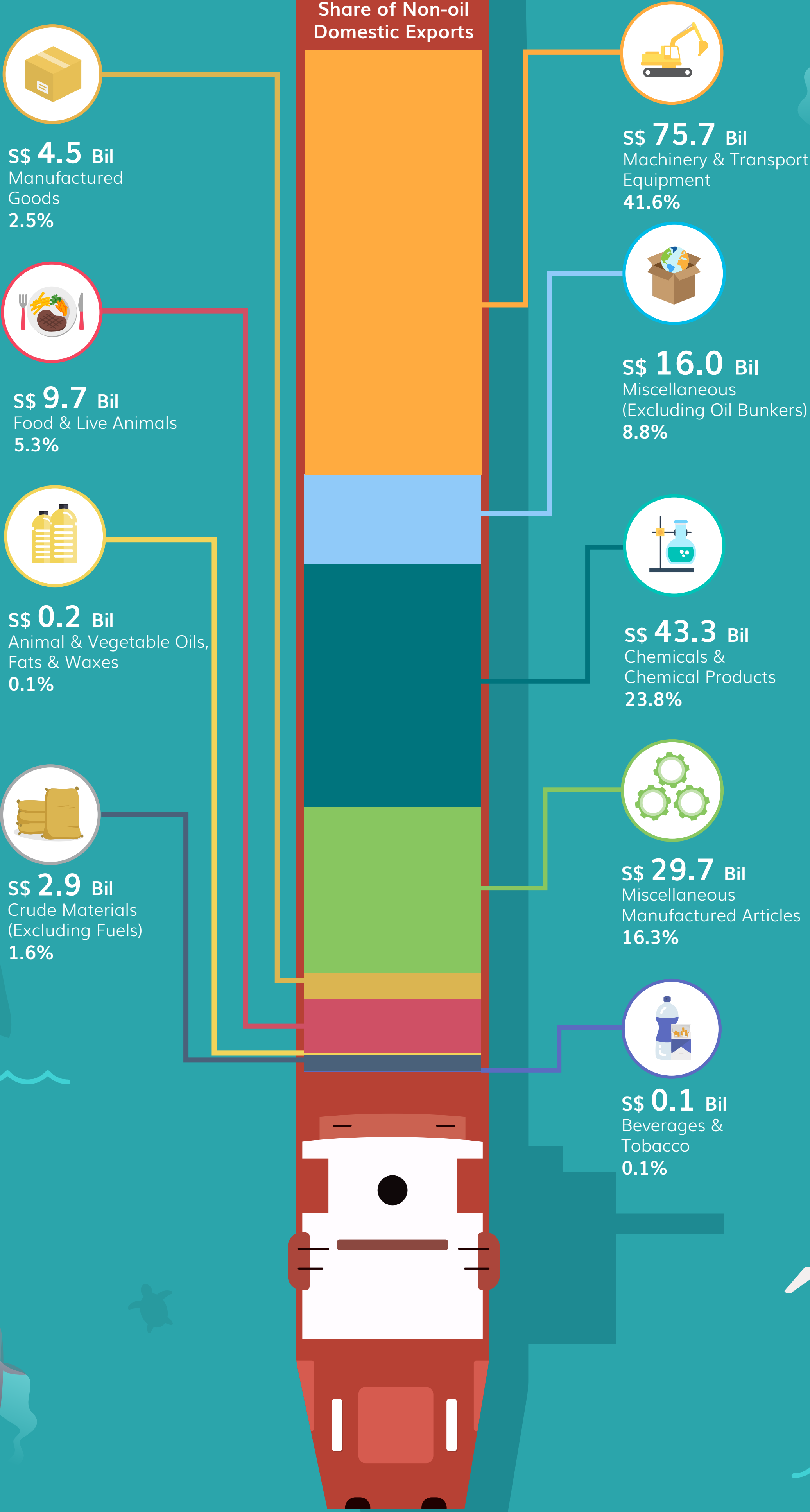

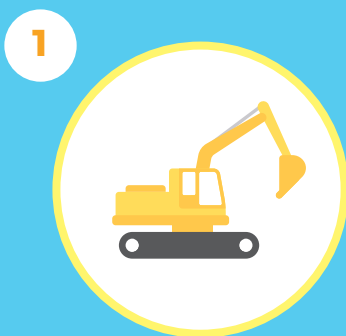


NON-OIL DOMESTIC EXPORTS

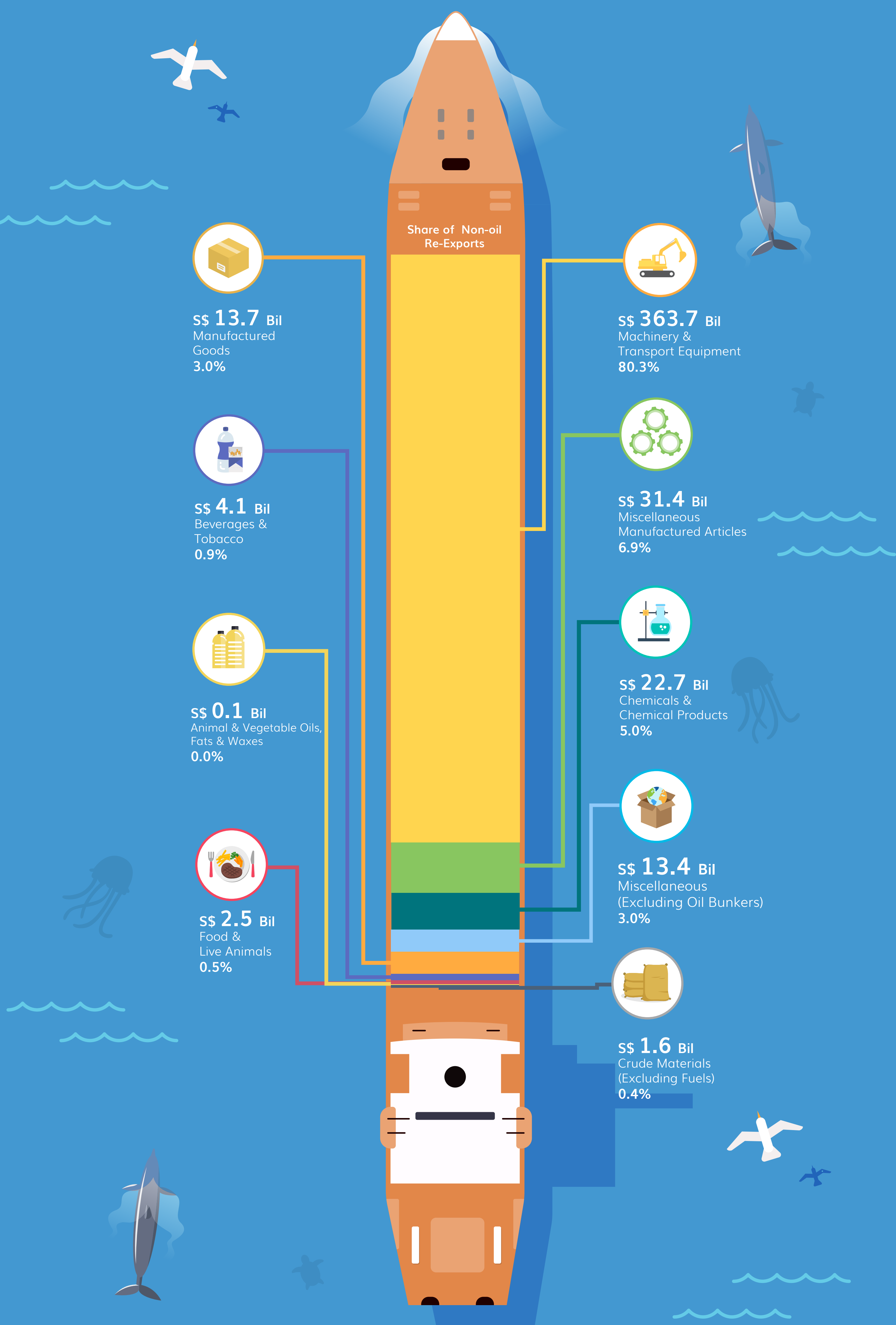

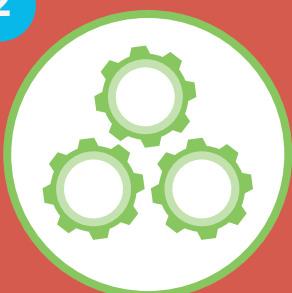

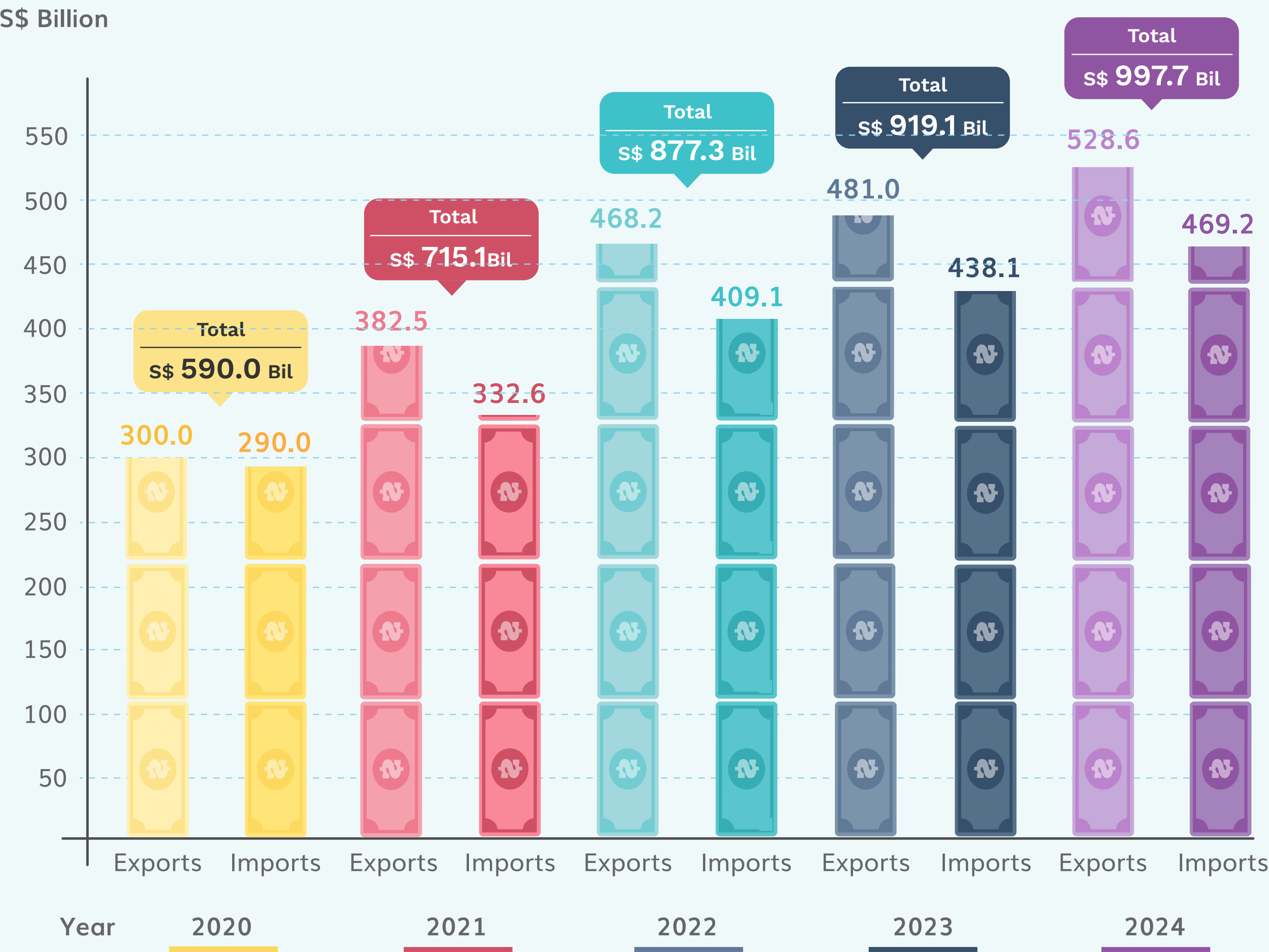

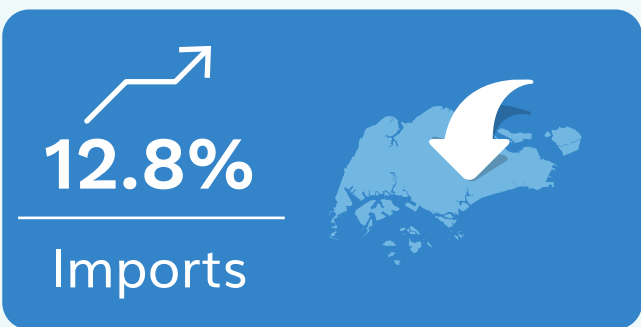

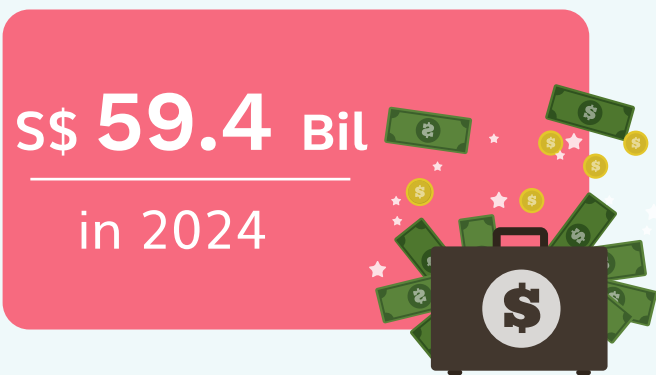
OVERALL EXPORTS AND IMPORTS OF SERVICES, 2020-2024

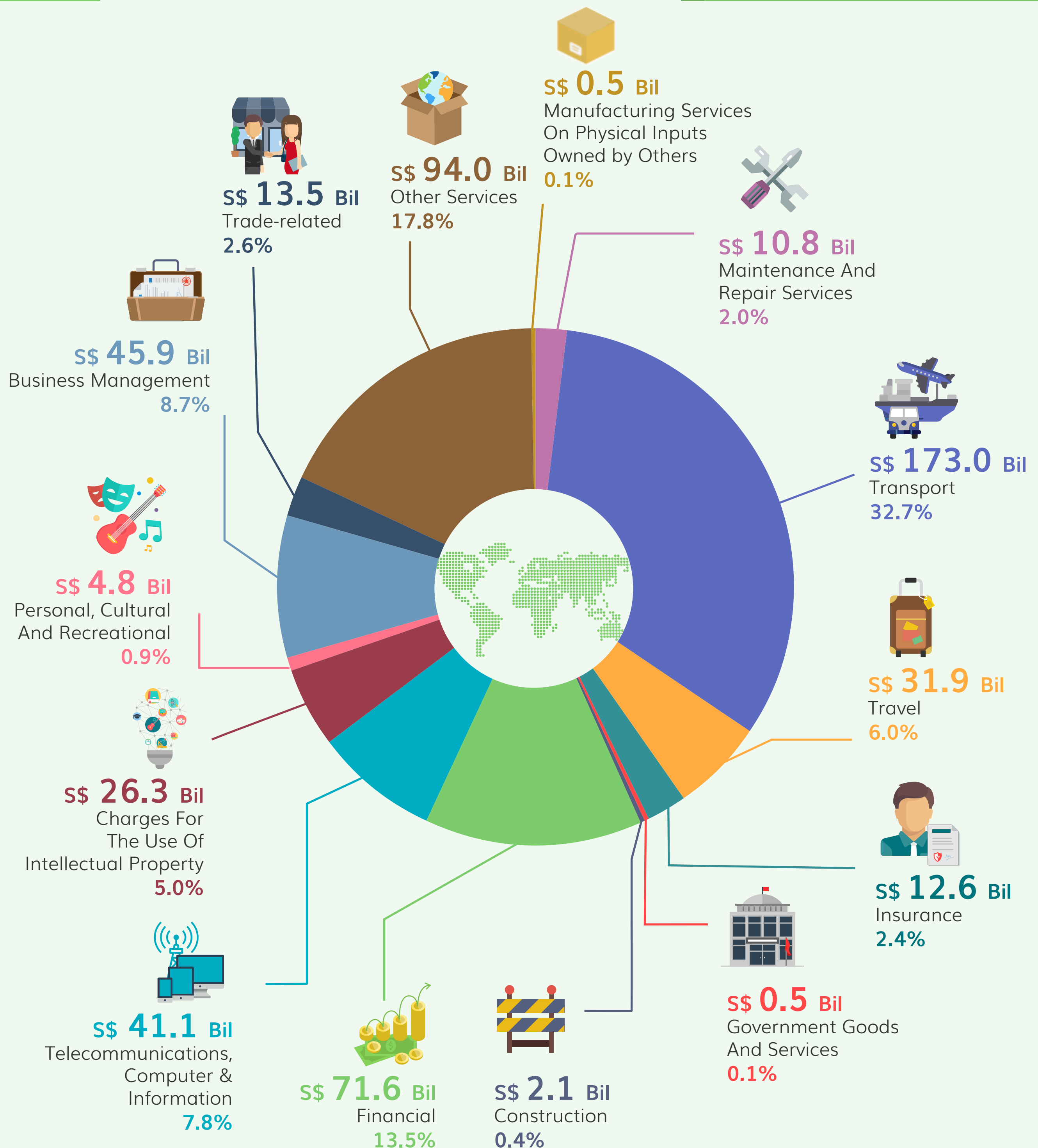

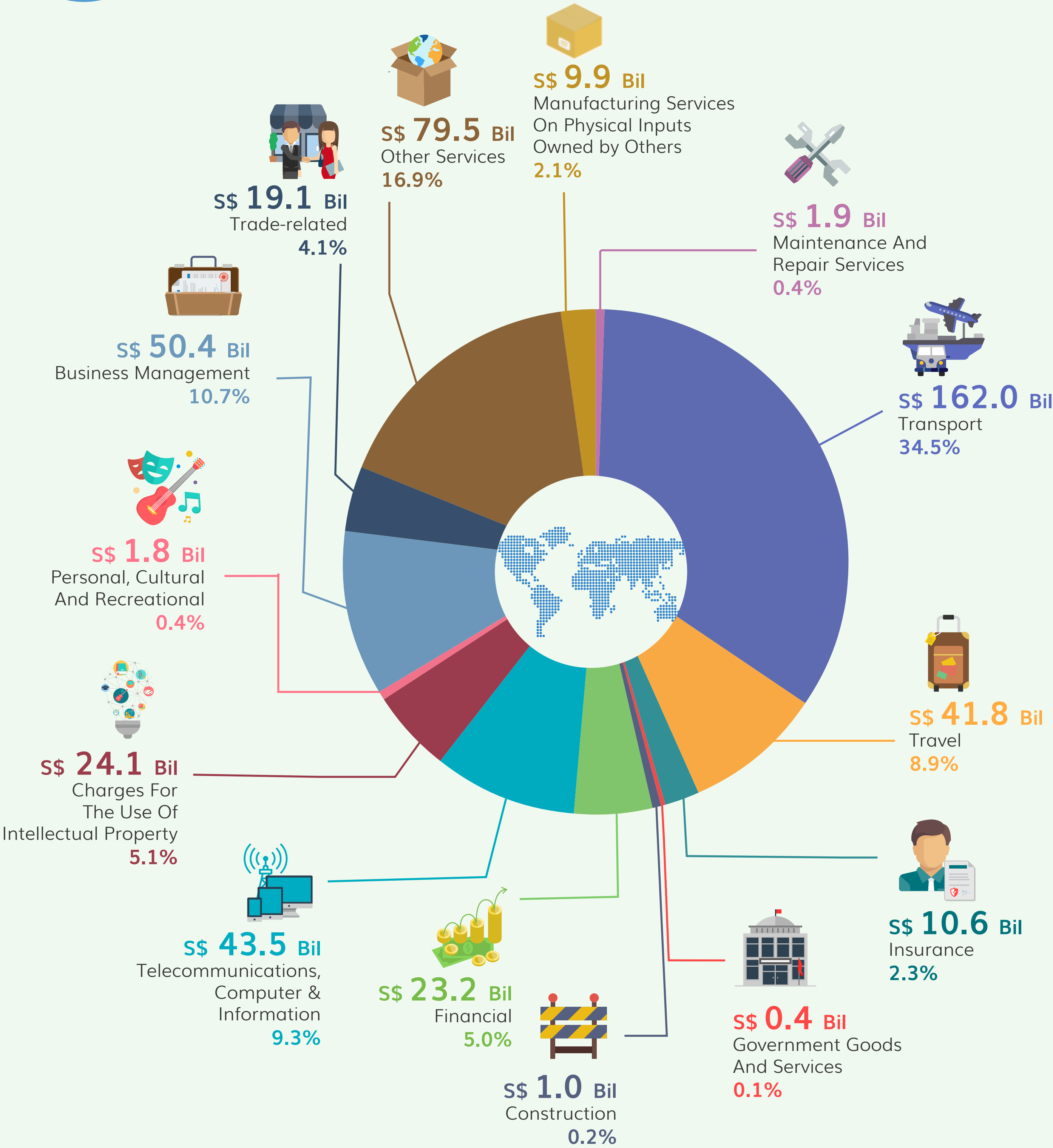
