Business Receipts for Services Industries Second Quarter 2026

Business Receipts for the Services industries¹ is a quarterly indicator that tracks the income earned by firms across Singapore's services sector. It provides insights on the short-term performance of the services industries, helping to guide business decisions and policy choices.

OVERVIEW – THE SERVICES SECTOR

Business receipts of the services sector¹ increased 25.5% on a year-on-year basis in the second quarter of 2026. Excluding Wholesale Trade, business receipts rose 15.5%.

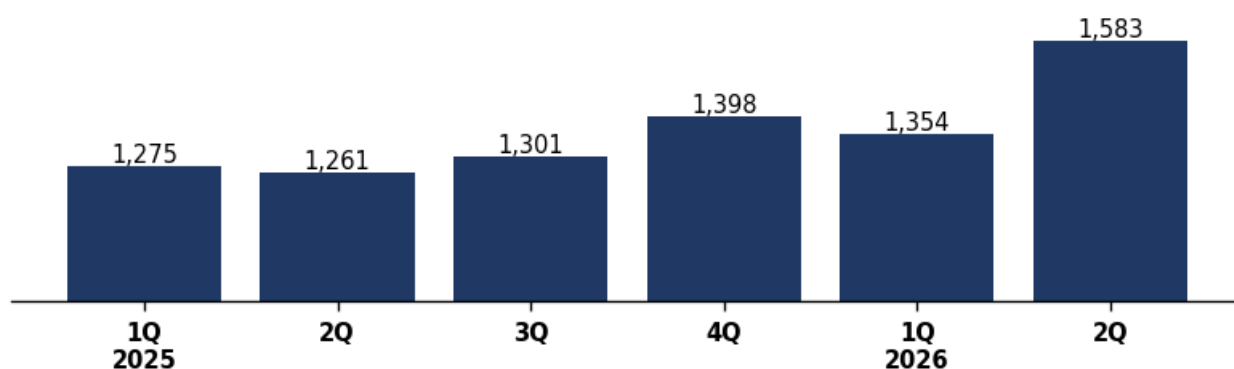
Compared to the previous quarter, business receipts (non-seasonally adjusted) grew by 16.9%. Excluding Wholesale Trade, business receipts expanded by 9.2%.

Business receipts of the services sector in the second quarter of 2026 were estimated at \$1,583 billion. Excluding Wholesale Trade, business receipts stood at approximately \$263 billion.

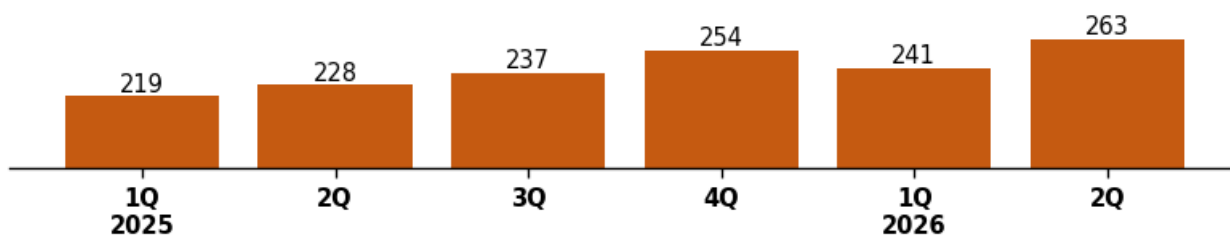

Year-on-Year Change

Within the services sector, all industries except Recreation & Personal Services and Food & Beverage Services recorded year-on-year growth in business receipts.

The Wholesale Trade industry reported a 27.8% growth in sales, mainly attributed to wholesale trade of electronic components and petroleum & petroleum products.

The Transportation & Storage industry registered an increase of 26.5% in turnover, with growth strongest in water transport, supported by elevated sea freight rates.

Conversely, the Recreation & Personal Services industry reported a 2.5% decline in receipts, mostly due to the decrease in revenue from arts, sports and recreational activities.

Quarter-on-Quarter Change (Non-seasonally adjusted)

On a quarter-on-quarter basis, all industries reported higher revenue except Retail Trade, Food & Beverage Services, Education and Recreation & Personal Services.

The Wholesale Trade industry reported an 18.6% increase in sales, attributed to the electronic components and petroleum & petroleum products subsectors.

The Transportation & Storage industry registered a growth of 16.4% in business receipts, mainly driven by shipping lines and logistics services.

The Education industry, on the other hand, saw a decrease of 13.4%, attributed to lower receipts reported by universities from the tuition fees received in 1Q 2026.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Data Coverage

The Quarterly Business Receipts for Services Industries (QBRS) covers Wholesale Trade, Retail Trade, Transportation & Storage, Food & Beverage Services, Information & Communications, Real Estate (excluding real estate developers), Professional Services, Administrative & Support Services, Education, Health & Social Services, and Recreation & Personal Services.

Data for Wholesale Trade, Retail Trade and Food & Beverage Services are sourced from the quarterly Wholesale Trade report and monthly Retail Sales and Food & Beverage Services report published by Singapore Department of Statistics (DOS) respectively. For more details on the performance of these industries, please refer to the respective industry reports on the SingStat Website.

Definition of Business Receipts

Business receipts refer to the income earned by firms from their business activities. For most industries covered within the scope of this report, business receipts comprise operating revenue from services rendered and sales of goods, including items such as professional and consultancy fees, administrative and management fees, commissions, rental and lease income, royalties and licence fees, and repair and servicing charges. Non-operating revenue such as interest income, investment earnings and government grants are excluded.

For the Wholesale & Retail Trade and Food & Beverage Services industries, business receipts are measured in terms of sales, as these represent the core business activity of these industries and constitute the predominant component of their operating revenue. For Wholesale Trade, business receipts cover domestic wholesale sales within Singapore and foreign wholesale sales outside of Singapore. The latter includes sales of off-shore merchandise, domestic exports, re-exports and transshipment cargo.

For Retail Trade and Food & Beverage Services, business receipts refer to the value of retail goods, or food and beverages sold to consumers during the period, excluding taxes on products such as Goods and Services Tax (GST), Additional Registration Fee (ARF) and Certificates of Entitlement (COE).

Data Source

Business receipts are compiled quarterly from administrative data from government agencies, and survey data collected by DOS through the Quarterly Survey of Services, the Monthly Survey of Retail Sales and the Monthly Survey of Food & Beverage Services.

Collectively, these sources cover more than 33,000 enterprises, of which 85% are drawn from administrative data.

In each reference quarter, firms with survey responses or available administrative data generally account for about 80% of the total operating revenue of all firms included in the QBRS compilation.

Data Compilation

Data on business receipts are compiled at current prices, using either a register-based or sample-based approach.

For industries where administrative data provides sufficiently comprehensive coverage, a register-based approach is adopted. Under this approach, data are obtained from all firms in the industry, primarily through administrative data and supplemented by direct surveys where necessary, with the aim of achieving full population coverage.

For industries where administrative data do not yet provide sufficiently comprehensive coverage, a sample-based approach is used. Under this approach, data from a sample of firms are collected and weighted to represent the broader industry population.
