

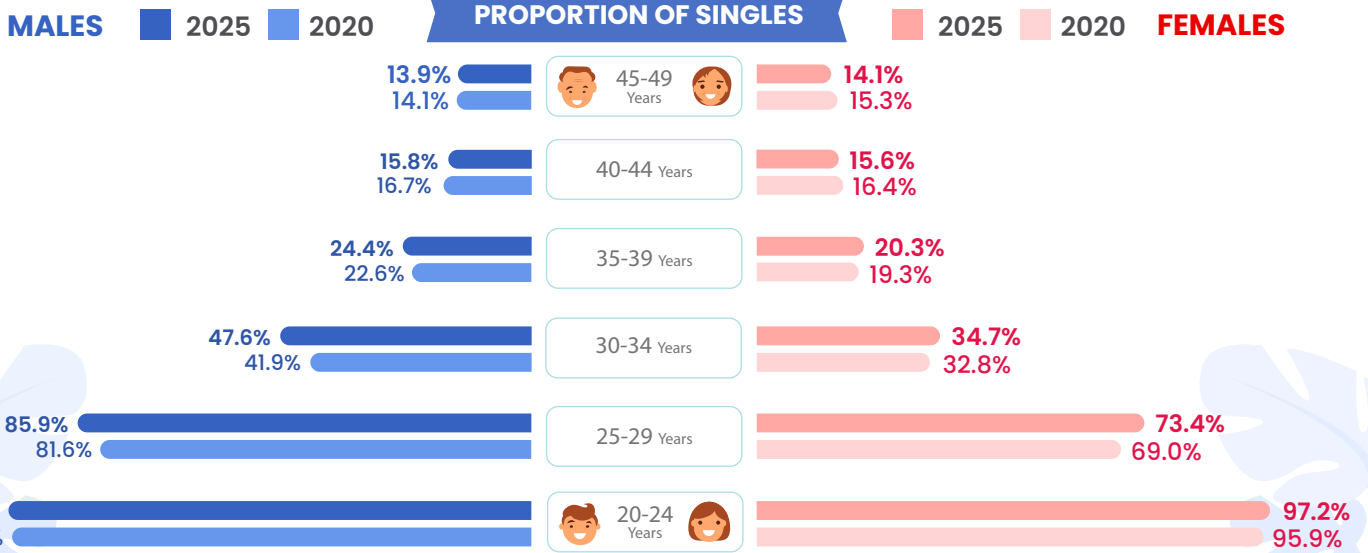

Marriage & Fertility

While singlehood among younger resident adults rose, most residents were married by their forties, majority of whom had 2 or more children.



Singlehood rose for younger residents aged below 40, with larger increases for those between 25–34 years.



Among ever-married resident females aged **40 – 49 years**, the average number of children born declined from **1.76 in 2020** to **1.67 in 2025**.

The majority still had 2 or more children, though this share decreased over the same period.

58.4% of ever-married resident females aged 40 – 49 years had 2 or more children (compared to 62.5% in 2020).
