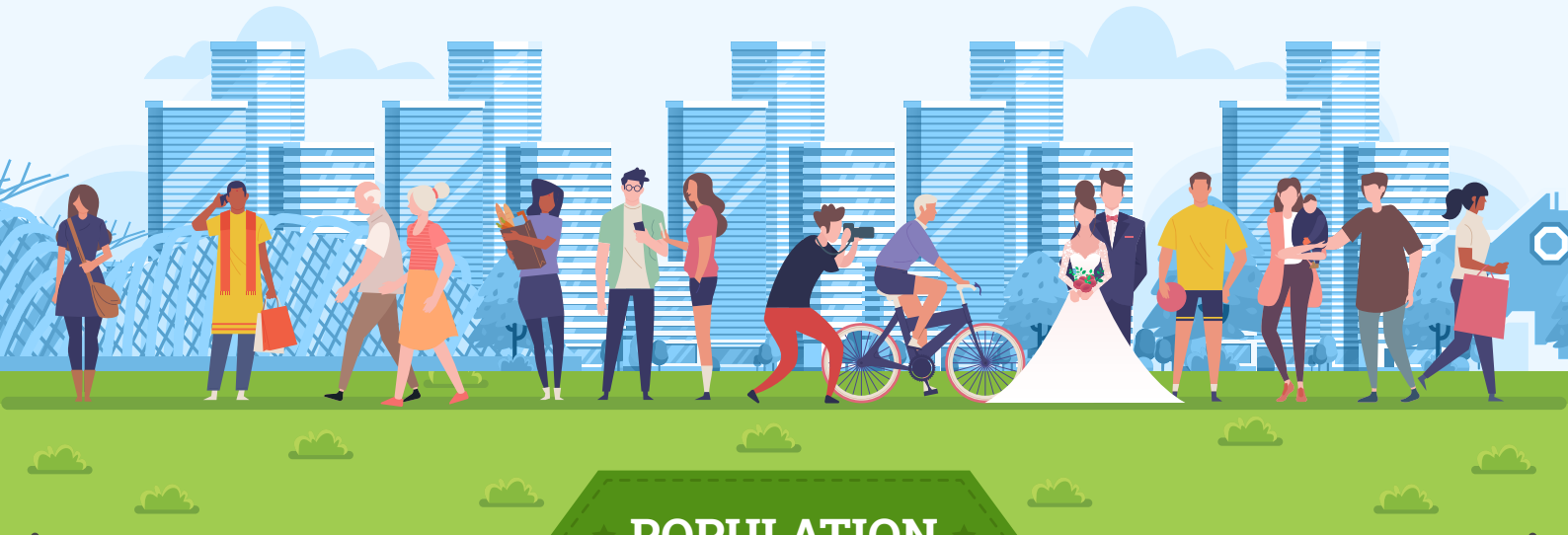

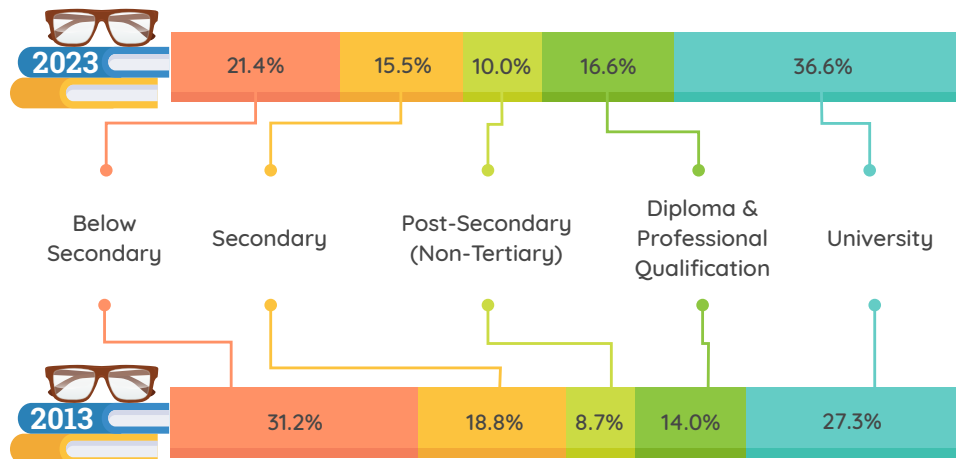

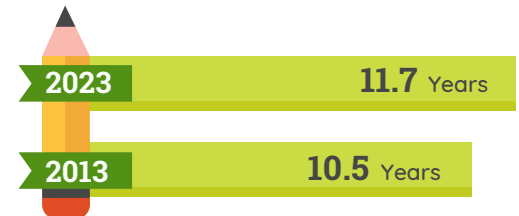
HIGHEST QUALIFICATION ATTAINED

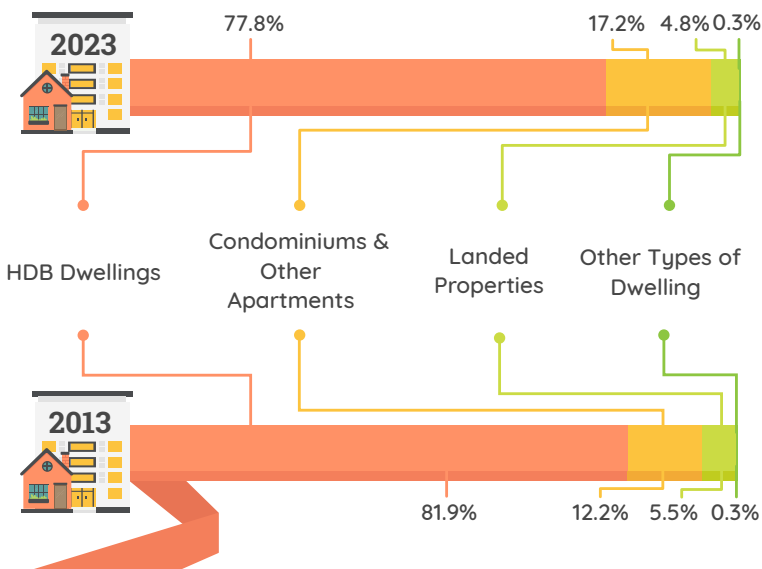

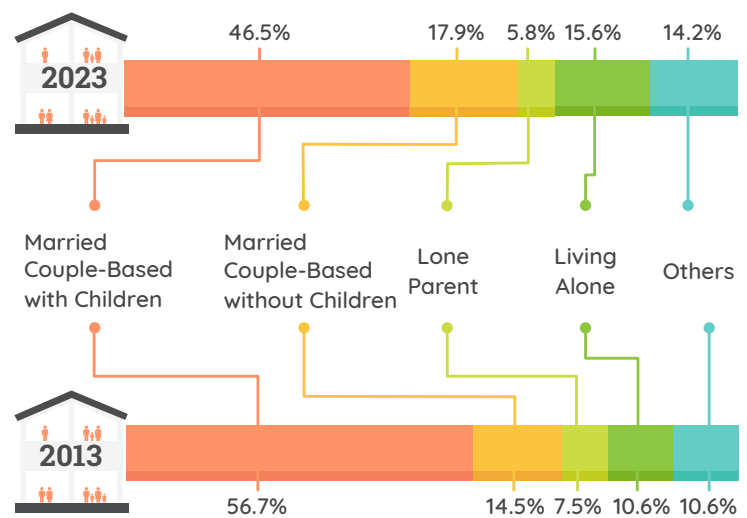

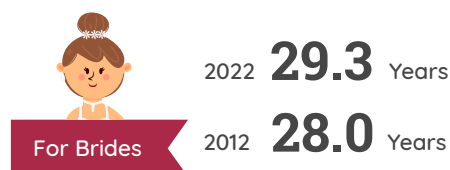
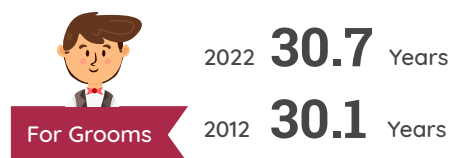

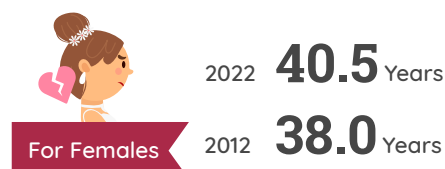
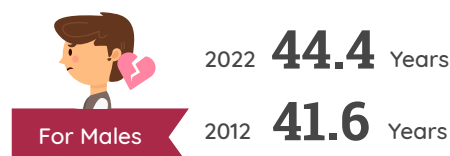

MEDIAN DURATION of MARRIAGES THAT ENDED IN DIVORCE



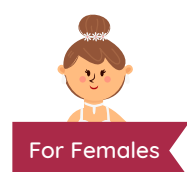

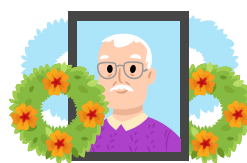

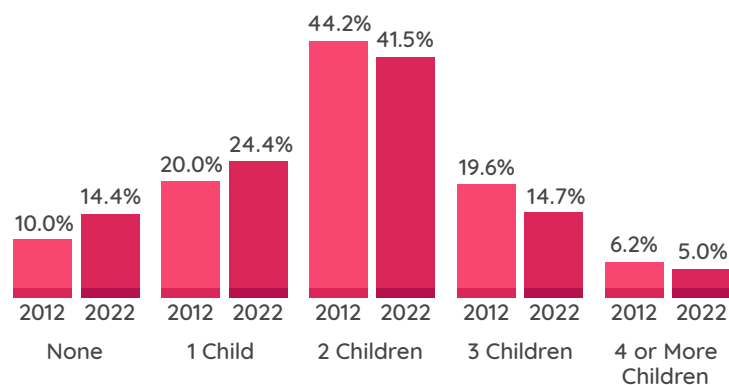
