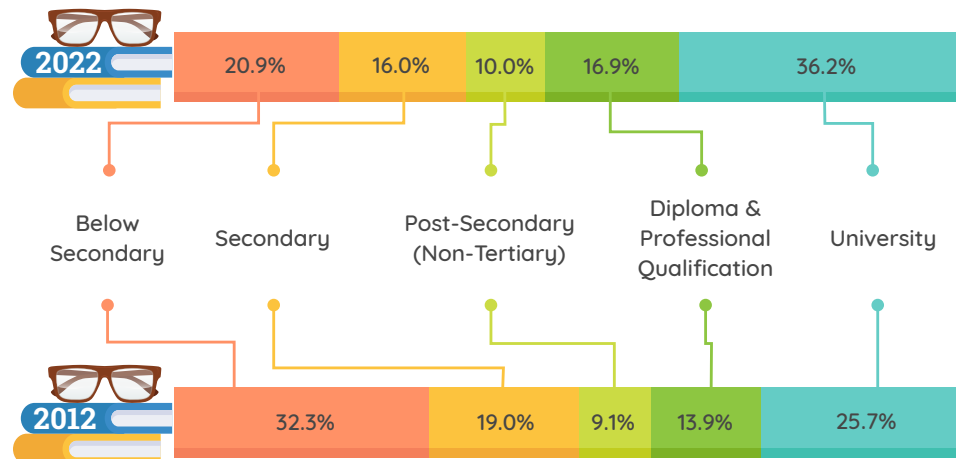

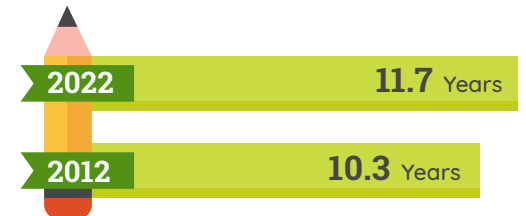
HIGHEST QUALIFICATION ATTAINED

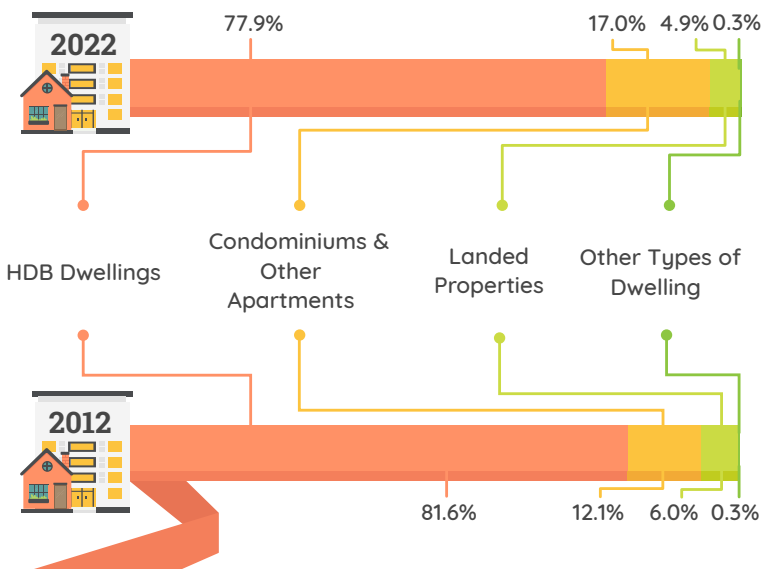

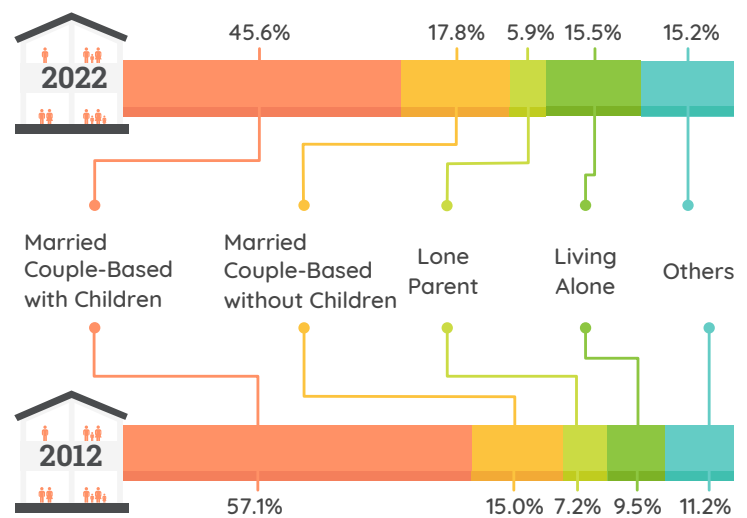

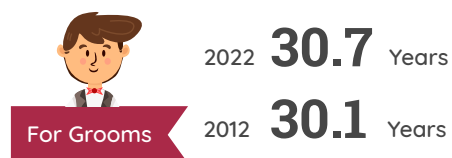

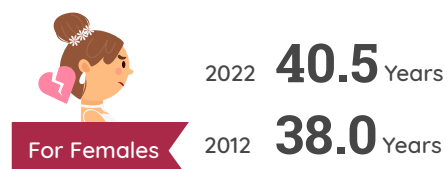
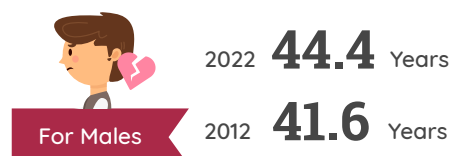

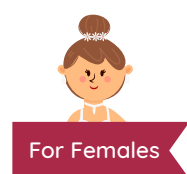

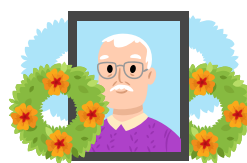

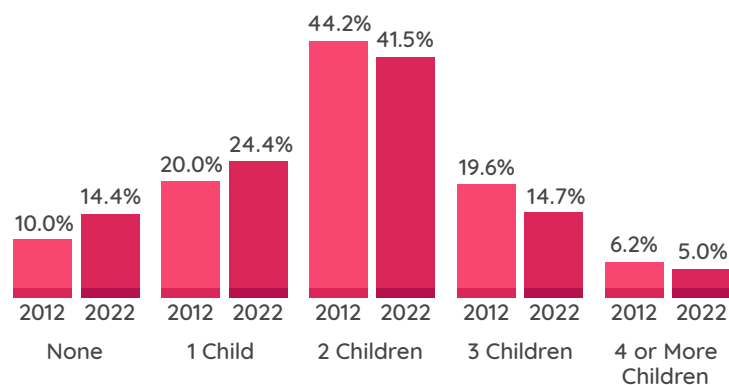


INFANT MORTALITY RATE
